ANGELA:

Thèid ceistean duilich a chur ort nuair a thèid thu gu agallamh airson obair. Mar eisimpleir, "Dè na laigsean a th' agad?"

Ceist chunnartach, ach tha ceistean ann nach saoil thu a tha cho dona, ach a tha a cheart cho cunnartach, mar, "Dè na cur-seachadan a th' agad?"

Innsidh do fhreagairt tàrr mu do dheidhinn - cus 's dòcha. Mas e snàmh agus ball-coise na cur-seachadan agad, dh'fhaodadh tu a ràdh: "Bidh mi a' snàmh a h-uile latha. "Bidh mi a' cluiche ball-coise a h-uile Diluain." Shealladh sin gun robh ùidh cheart agad anns na cur-seachadan. "Bidh mi a' sreap nam beann, is mi a' feuchainn ri mullach a h-uile Rothaich a ruighinn." Ùidh mhòr agus amas - flor mhath.

Bi foghlamaichte: "Tha mi ag ionnsachadh na Gàidhlig, agus tha mi a' faighinn air adhart math dha-rìribh." Dh'fhaodadh seo a bhith fior: "Bidh mi a' coimhead an telebhisein a h-uile h-oidhche tron t-seachdain "agus a' gabhail na daoraich Oidhche Shathairne."

ANGELA:

You will be asked difficult questions when you go to a job interview. For example, "What are your weaknesses?"

A dangerous question, but there are questions, which you might not think are so bad, but which are just as dangerous, like, "What are your hobbies?"

Your answer will tell a lot about you - perhaps too much. If your hobbies are swimming and football, you could say: "I swim every day. "I play football every Monday." That would show that you have a real interest in your hobbies. "I climb hills, and I'm trying to reach the summit of every Munro." A strong interest and a goal - very good.

Be educated: "I am learning Gaelic, and I'm getting on very well." This could be true: "I watch television every night of the week "and get drunk every Saturday night."

ANGELA:

Ach, bi glic. An còrdadh e ris an luchd-fhastaidh? Bhiodh e na b' fheàrr a chur mar seo: "Bidh mi a' leantainn spòrs agus dràma, "agus bidh mi an sàs anns na dhà còmhla ri caraidean air an deireadh-sheachdain."

Caraidean - bruidhinn mu rudan a bhios tu a' dèanamh còmhla ri daoine eile. Cha bhiodh e ro mhath nam biodh an luchd-fastaidh den bheachd gur e duine aonranach a bh' annad. Shaoileadh iad sin nan canadh tu: "S e fear-amhairc thrèanaichean a th' annam, aig amannan." Agus - "aig amannan" - car leam-leat. Tha e math a bhith a' faighinn air adhart le daoine - ach buileach math ma bhios thu gan cuideachadh.

Bi taiceil: "Bidh mi ag obair do charthannas tric is minig, "agus gan cuideachadh le iomairtean a h-uile cothrom a gheibh mi."

Agus, bi mionaideach: "Bidh mi ag obair gu saor-thoileach aig sutha "agus a' toirt biadh do thrì muncaidhean deug air fhichead gach Dihaoine. "Tha dhà ann a bhios gam bhìdeadh nuair a lùbas mi."

Agus aon rud eile - bi onarach. Innis an fhìrinn.

Bheir sinn sùil air ais air cuid de na facail agus abairtean a bh' agam.

ANGELA:

But be sensible. Would the interviewers like that? It would be better to put it like this: "I follow sport and drama, "and I get involved in both with friends at the weekend."

Friends - talk about things you do along with other people. It wouldn't be very good if the interviewers believed you to be a loner. They might think so if you said: "I am an occasional train spotter." And - "occasional" – quite fickle. It's very good to get along with people - but even more so if you help them.

Be supportive: "I do work for a charity regularly and often, "and help them with initiatives every chance I get."

And go into detail: "I work as a volunteer at a zoo "and feed 33 monkeys every Friday. "Two of them bite me every time I bend down."

And one more thing - be honest. Tell the truth.
