Choice of method or procedure

Participants are expected to use the test method, calibration, or measurement procedure of their choice. Some samples may require specific preparation or analysis, if so, this is indicated in this document.

Participants may submit results for some, or all the parameters requested.

Sample Details

- Microbiological test materials represent a 'real' chocolate or cocoa powder sample, which may or may not contain the target organism(s), at a range of inoculum levels. Background flora may also be present.
- Samples PT-CT-710. and PT-CT-714. are provided as a set, labelled A & B. These
 will have different contents and should be clearly labelled, handled, tested, and
 always reported separately to avoid mixing up the two samples.
