

# Instructions

All our products are thoughtfully designed and expertly manufactured. So that you get the most out of your new light we offer the following guidelines to assist you.

1 x Base • 1 x Shade • 1 x American Harp • 1 x Finial

## Important Information

- To prevent electrocution switch off at the mains supply before assembling or maintaining.
- Always be sure to use the correct type and wattage of bulbs as indicated on the fitting. Never exceed the wattage stated, this may cause your light fitting to overheat.
- When changing the bulb, always switch off the supply and allow the old bulb to cool down before handling. Dispose of bulbs carefully.
- The external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire cannot be replaced. If the cord is damaged the luminaire shall be destroyed.

## Before Starting

Please read through these instructions before assembling product and retain for future reference. Keep all packaging until after successful installation.

## Assembly Instructions

### **Step 1**

Unpacked your lamp and remove all packaging.

### **Step 2 (Refer to fig 1)**

To shade your table lamp, unscrew the finial if it is currently attached to the threaded stud of the harp. Lift the harp sleeves then gently squeeze the harp to fit it into the harp bottom. Lower the sleeves back into position.

### **Step 3 (Refer to fig 2)**

Place shade over the american harp then screw the finial to the top threaded stud.

### **Step 4**

Refer to wattage labels on your lampholder/shade gimble to select correct bulb (not supplied) for your lamp. Use the label to ensure you have the correct fitting type, bulb shape and wattage. Screw bulb into place.

### **Step 5**

Adjust to desired position.

### **Step 6**

Plug your lamp into your power socket with the power off.

### **Step 7**

Finally power on the lamp using power switch.

## Location

- This product is suitable for indoor use only.
- Ensure the lamp is located where the power cable will not cause an accident.
- Place lamp on a level surface.

## Cleaning Care

Always switch off supply before cleaning. Clean with a soft dry cloth. Do not use abrasive materials as this may damage your product.

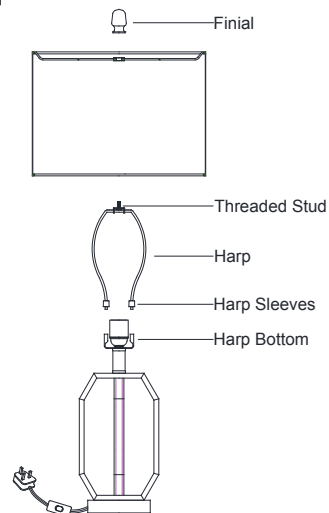
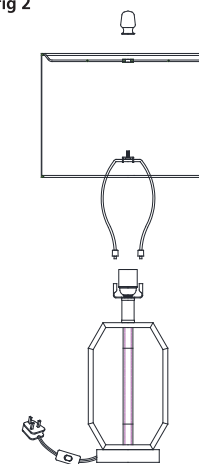
