Subtitle Editor Cheat Sheet

EXPORT SUBTITLES

Export subtitles as: EBU-TT-D, SRT, STL, WebVTT

Export

back to Flow library

clip navigation

Change working area by toggling panes on and off

Real-time subtitle preview

Timecode and frame-by-frame stepping

Subtitle edit controls (shortcuts F8 → F10, Shift+Enter, Esc)

Player controls (shortcuts F1 → F7)

- MARK COMPLETED
 - Mark Complete
 - Delete Subtitles
 - Replace with SRT / STL
- ▶ Mark 'completed' indicates subtitling work is done.
- ▶ Delete Subtitles also resets status to 'not yet started'.
- ▶ Replace with SRT / STL to upload your existing subtitles

Flow Library allows filtering on subtitle status

PLAYER SHORTCUTS

Rewind Player 1 second

Toggle Play / Pause

Forward Player 1 second

Previous Clip

Slower / Reverse Playback

Faster Playback

Next Clip

F1 Go to previous clip

F2 Rewind player 1 second. Hold shift to rewind 1 frame

F3 Slower or reverse playback

F4 Toggle Play / Pause

F5 Faster playback

F6 Forward player 1 second. Hold shift to forward 1 frame

F7 Go to next clip

SUBTITLE EDIT SHORTCUTS

Play IN to OUT

Set IN to Player Position

Set OUT to Player Position

Save changes

F8 Play time range of subtitle being edited

F9 Set IN of subtitle being edited to the current playhead position

F10 Like F9 but sets OUT. It also pauses the player.

Shift+Enter If a subtitle is being edited, save the changes. If no subtitle is being edited, start editing the subtitle at the playhead position (if any)

Esc Abort edit of current subtitle, don't save changes

cmd / ctrl + Enter Split the subtitle in two subtitles at the cursor position

mac windows + ↑ Merge the subtitle with the previous subtitle

mac windows + ↓ Merge the subtitle with the next subtitle

MAC USER? Hold fn key while pressing F1, F2, ... and use cmd instead of ctrl

CREATE A NEW SUBTITLE

+ ADD SUBTITLE

playhead position when F9 was pressed

defaults to 1s duration

playhead position when F10 was pressed

SET IN

SET OUT

SAVING SUBTITLE

Type your description. Press F10 when player reaches desired OUT point.

F9 sets the IN point to the playhead position.

F10 sets the OUT point to the playhead position and pauses player

Shift+Enter saves the subclip
