2. Matters Arising

Sw Môr Môn – a response regarding the bus stop. Clerk emailed to discuss planning permission and a fee. Response – they state that they do not need planning permission. Uncertain which stops they want to do. Not keen to pay a fee. One advantage would be that this would keep the bus stops tidy – but on the other hand this is a considerable revenue possibility. The situation with Greenwood – the company paid for a new bus stop in that situation. Need to offer prices. Continue to discuss with them – but if there is no income to us then it's not worth doing.

The untidy patch on the path from the playground discussed. Who owns this? Needs to be tidied and have a community project. Have had a discussion with the Marquis' forestry manager.

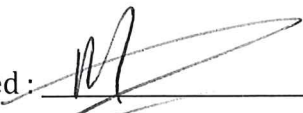
9. Report of any Meetings
