



Club Information

Welcome to Shaikly Netball Club.

As members of England Netball, all Shaikly Netball Club participants need to join, and there is a guide to assist you with registration. [England Netball | Children's Membership Checklist](#)

After you have registered, please let us know and we will attach your membership, where you will then need to make the payment (the fee differs depending on age and can be found on the ENGage website).

For existing members, please renew your current membership by logging in to Engage.

No training or league games can be played until membership is complete.

Training Session Details

Day: Wednesday (term time only)
Time: 6.30 - 7.30pm or 7.45 - 9pm
Place: Philip Morant School, Rembrandt Way, Colchester. CO3 4QS (outdoor courts)
Age: School years 3-11

For training, all players will need to:

- ✓ Wear comfortable clothing i.e. jogging bottoms / leggings and a Shaikly t-shirt/ sweatshirt
- ✓ Wear suitable trainers with a good tread (not flimsy pumps or fashion trainers)
- ✓ Have long hair tied back
- ✓ Ensure nails are short
- ✓ Remove any jewelry before they attend, including earrings
- ✓ Bring a drink

If a player is late for a training session or match, she will still be expected to warm up before participating.

If a player is unable to attend a training session or match, you must contact the coach/club as soon as possible. **If a player regularly misses sessions or has 3 consecutive sessions off with no legitimate reason, they will be placed on the waiting list and their membership in the club will be offered to another player.**

Older members' sessions may include the use of weights. Please notify the club should your child need to be excluded.

The responsibilities of training are by Level 2 Coaches, sometimes with the assistance of Level 1 Coaches and volunteers. New and younger coaches are also overseen by Level 2 coaches, but with coaches in training delivering the sessions.

Mobile Phones

The use of mobile phones is not permitted on court. They are a distraction and we cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage (as with other valuables or personal belongings). Coaches carry a mobile phone in their kit bag during training and games, in case of emergencies. Where possible, please leave phones at home or with a parent.

Club Membership Fees

Club membership fees are payable in advance via Teamo by direct debit. In order to keep monthly payments lower, they are spread over 12 months. Therefore, payments will be taken during the summer months when there are no training or games.

There are two membership options:

Quarterly Membership

4 payments of £55 in September, December, March and June.

Monthly Membership

12 monthly payments of £21

You will notice there is a discount for members who pay quarterly. Please note that failing to make payments will result in exclusion from forthcoming training.

Membership fees cover all training sessions and league matches. Additional items such as uniform, rallies & tournaments, events or master classes, incur an extra charge.

Team Selection

Players will be selected into the teams based on the following selection criteria. The more flexible a player can be, covering 3 positions for example, will provide more opportunities to play:

- ✓ Commitment to training, attitude and contribution made at training sessions.
- ✓ The assessment of each player's key skills as displayed at training.
- ✓ The ability of a player to focus, both at training and during games.
- ✓ The potential for a player to improve and respond to coaching.
- ✓ Overall impact with other selected players in that team.

Selection for each team will be made after the previous training session whereupon the player will be informed. Club coaches make the selections, providing explanations to the decision making and procedure. Decisions cannot be made on game participation when they are not present at training sessions.

Membership alone does not guarantee a place on the playing team each week. Teams will be selected on a game-by-game basis, while aiming to remain competitive in the league.

On occasions, players may be required to substitute for another team within the club to ensure game play.

Players are not guaranteed to play for the same team throughout the season. Where required, the club may change players/teams to allow the best outcome for individuals and teams.

League Games

League games usually start in November for youth and September for adults, and as soon as we have the list of fixtures we will circulate this information. We would appreciate it if you could check the fixture dates and notify us of any dates a player is unable to attend. This helps us to have an idea of any potential team selection issues early on.

All youth games are played at The Gilberd School, Brinkley Lane, Colchester CO4 9PU on a Thursday evening. Times to be confirmed by the league. Transport is not provided.

Medical Needs

Please notify us if a player has any medical needs or injuries which might impact on her training or game play. Please ensure any inhalers or EpiPens are brought to all training sessions and games. Shaikly Netball Club is not responsible for carrying any personal medication.

There will always be a qualified First Aider at training and league games, and all coaches carry a first aid kit / ice packs, which are sometimes administered for any bumps or bruises. Please notify us of any special considerations.

Shaikly Netball Club Coaches securely store your contact details in order to manage their team and enable them to contact you in case of emergency. Please ensure all details on ENgage are correct.

We may use photographs that include images of our players on the Shaikly Netball Club and Colchester Netball League websites, Facebook, and Instagram. You will be asked for consent on the registration form. This is for any photos, media or quotations to be used. Please notify us should the player be excluded from this.

Shaikly Netball Club only uses information gathered in relation to our youth teams that meets the specific responsibilities, as set out in General Data Protection Regulations. However, from time to time we will contact you with details of fixtures, events, competitions and other information regarding the club.

We will store your information on our youth team database for a maximum of 18 months unless re-registering. When required, we also pass your details on to internal club contacts, netball tournaments, netball leagues, County Netball Association and England Netball for the purposes of competition, monitoring, reporting and applying for funding and development opportunities.

Code of Conduct

Teamwork is essential in Netball and as a club, we are very focussed on this, respecting and encouraging our teammates, managers, coaches and officials. We believe this is very important and something we are proud to say is part of our club ethos.

Teamo and Social Media

At present we are using Teamo as a method of contacting you regarding updates, fixtures etc. You will be sent a link when joining the club which, when registration is completed, will give you access to the main calendar for your team. All training sessions and fixtures are easily accessible and you will be able to state your child's availability for each game. There is a comprehensive messaging system built into the app, so all club and team messaging will be sent through Teamo. If you have any problems with how it works, we're always happy to help.

Coaches, volunteers and officials are unable to accept friend requests from any players under the age of 16 on any social media platform. For players in the junior league, all contact is to be made via a parent/guardian or authorised adult, unless specific arrangements have been made.

We often update our Facebook page with team reports, event information, and photos. This is a closed group, but all current members of the club are welcome to join. (Children must be 13 to have a Facebook account.) We also have a club website www.shaiklynetball.com where all fixtures can be seen, along with news about individual teams and anything that's going on with the club.

Kit

The league requires compulsory club dress to be worn at each game. Additional clothing, such as long or short sleeved tops can also be worn under dresses. Other items such as club socks, t-shirts, hoodies and sweatshirts are available via Teamo. Other items are available through a third party - a kit list is available on request. **Please note that no other clothing/kit is permitted to be worn during games.**

The club provides new dresses to order, at a cost, and subject to availability. A £5 discount is received when a new dress is required, if exchanging a good condition pre-owned dress. This discount can be used towards purchasing a brand new dress or another nearly-new dress. Kit orders will be placed on a half-termly basis, or when necessary.
