



	Changes for Children from 1 st June 2020
1	Am sessions will now be 8.45am to 11.45pm
2	Children will use separate doors for arrival and collection as follows: East Site – Red, Indigo, Yellow and Blue Groups will use the dining room entrance. Orange, Green and Violet will use the main door. West Site – Red, Orange, Blue and Yellow groups will use the garden door entrance. Indigo and Violet will use the main front entrance. If you are not sure what colour your child's key group is this can be found on your EyLog profile.
4	Immediately after entry children will be required to wash their hands using the additional sinks provided, if they are unable to do this for any reason hand gel will be available. Hand washing will continue at key points during the session.
5	To ensure children are kept as safe as possible while attending they have been allocated a set play space with their key group, their group will continue to access the garden space where they also have an allocated play space.
6	Children's snack, and lunch if they attend all day, will be in their key group area or room.
7	Only children who are toilet training should bring with them a change bag, children will not be permitted to bring with them any toys or comforters from home.
8	Hot lunches will NOT be provided, children will be required to bring a packed lunch.
9	Resources and equipment which cannot easily be cleaned and sanitised will be temporarily removed.
10	If a child demonstrates a new persistent cough or a temperature of 38 degrees whilst in the setting they will be isolated with their key worker or co-key worker until you collect them. They, and your family members, must then follow the government guidelines for isolation.

	In order to help us manage the risks to children further we ask the following of Parents and Carers:
1	Do not send your child to pre-school if they have a new persistent cough or a high temperature or suffered a loss or change in their sense of taste or smell.
2	Only parents who are symptom free and or have completed the required isolation periods will drop off or collect their child
3	If you suspect anyone in your household has the symptoms of Coronavirus please seek medical guidance and get tested. If the test is returned as positive notify us immediately.
4	One person per family drops off and collects their child where possible.
5	Arrival and collection hand overs will be carried out at your allocated doors, observing 2m guidelines.
6	Please follow 2m distancing when queuing. 2m Markers will be placed on the floor as guidance.
7	Buggies, car seats, scooters, bikes etc may NOT be left at the setting premises.
8	We would recommend that your child's clothing is washed after being at the setting on a 60 degree cycle.
