

GUIDELINES FOR VISITING

Before you arrive




1 Take your temperature before travelling. If your temperature reading is higher than 38°C or you have a new continuous cough or a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell you should not attend site.



2 Consider your travel options and use a car, motorcycle, bicycle or walk to site where possible, in accordance with the current UK Government guidance.

When you arrive



1 Report to the Stage Door. If others are already in attendance then please wait in the clearly marked queuing area. Only one person will be allowed in the Stage Door lobby at a time.



2 As you enter your temperature will be taken automatically using a thermal imaging camera. Please be aware that if your temperature reading is abnormally high you will be asked to leave the site.



3 Once you are called forward by the Stage Door attendant, move into the lobby and use the hand sanitiser provided.



4 A disposable face covering and gloves will be provided for use during your visit.

During your visit



5 You must wear a face covering in areas where you cannot maintain a 2 metre distance from others.



6 Follow the clearly marked one-way routes through the building and, where possible, maintain a 2 metre distance from others whilst you are on site.



7 Common contact surfaces and toilet facilities will be regularly cleaned and sanitised by our on-site cleaning team.



8 Please wash your hands before and after using toilet facilities and sanitise your hands regularly using the products provided.

When you are leaving



1 Report to the Stage Door. If others are already in attendance then please wait until you are called forward by the Stage Door attendant.



2 Remove your face covering and gloves and place the items directly in the bin provided.



3 Use the hand sanitiser provided.

HOW TO PUT ON, USE, TAKE OFF AND DISPOSE OF A FACE COVERING




1 Before putting on a face covering, wash hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.



2 Cover mouth and nose with face covering and make sure there are no gaps between your face and the face covering.

Avoid touching the face covering while using it; if you do, clean your hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.



3 Replace the face covering with a new one as soon as it is damp and do not re-use single-use face coverings.



4 To remove the face covering: remove it from behind (do not touch the front of face covering); discard immediately in a closed bin; wash hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.
