David Cassuto was born in Florence, Italy in 1937. His father, Nathan, served as a doctor and as chief rabbi of the Florence Jewish community. In 1943, as deportations of Italian Jewry to the extermination camps began, Nathan and his wife were sent to Auschwitz, whilst the family scattered to different hiding places. David, his brother and sister survived the war and immigrated to pre-state Israel where they were looked after by their paternal grandparents.
