

LC 2017: PAPER 2

QUESTION 8 (60 MARKS)

Question 8 (a)

Population: $\mu = 63.5$ kg, $\sigma = 10$ kg

(i) Mariska: $X = 50$ kg

$$Z = \frac{x - \mu}{\sigma} = \frac{50 - 63.5}{10} = -1.35$$

$$P(x > 50) = P(z > -1.35) = P(z \leq 1.35) \\ = 0.9115 = 91.15\%$$

(ii) Kamal: $X = ?$

$$P(Z > z) = 0.015$$

$$1 - P(Z \leq z) = 0.015$$

$$P(Z \leq z) = 1 - 0.015 = 0.985 \Rightarrow Z = 2.17$$

$$Z = \frac{X - \mu}{\sigma} \Rightarrow 2.17 = \frac{X - 63.5}{10}$$

$$21.7 + 63.5 = X$$

$$X = 85.2 \text{ kg}$$

(iii) Null hypothesis $H_0: \mu = 63.5$ kg [Weight has **not** changed from 2015 to 2016]

Alternative hypothesis $H_1: \mu \neq 63.5$ kg [Weight has changed from 2015 to 2016]

$$\text{Sample: } n = 150, \bar{x} = 62 \text{ kg}, \bar{\sigma} = \frac{\sigma}{\sqrt{n}} = \frac{10}{\sqrt{150}}$$

$$z \text{ statistic: } \bar{z} = \frac{\bar{x} - \mu}{\bar{\sigma}} = \frac{62 - 63.5}{\frac{10}{\sqrt{150}}} = -1.84$$

$$\bar{z} = -1.84 > -1.96 \text{ [Do not reject } H_0 \text{]}$$

or

$$p = 2\{1 - P(z < |-1.84|)\} = 2\{1 - P(z < 1.84)\} \\ = 2\{1 - (0.9671)\} = 0.0658$$

$$p = 0.0658 > 0.05 \text{ [Do not reject } H_0 \text{]}$$

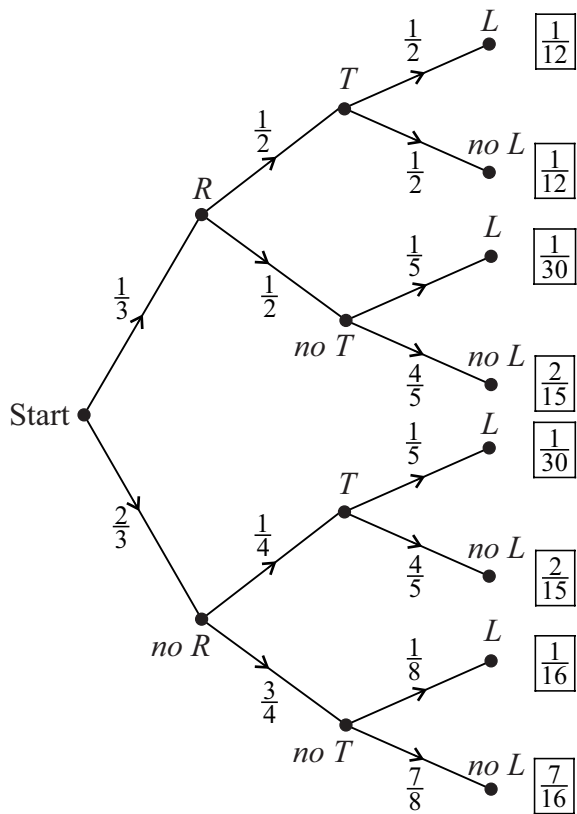
$$z = \frac{x - \mu}{\sigma}$$

n = Number in the sample

σ = standard deviation of the sample

$$\bar{z} = \frac{\bar{x} - \bar{\mu}}{\bar{\sigma}}, \text{ where } \bar{\mu} = \mu \text{ and } \bar{\sigma} = \frac{\sigma}{\sqrt{n}}.$$

Question 8 (b) (ii)

$$P(L) = \frac{1}{12} + \frac{1}{30} + \frac{1}{30} + \frac{1}{16} = \frac{17}{80}$$

Question 8 (b) (ii)

$$P(B|A) = \frac{P(A \cap B)}{P(A)}$$

$$\begin{aligned}
 P(R|L) &= \frac{P(R \cap L)}{P(L)} = \frac{P(R \text{ and then } L)}{P(L)} \\
 &= \frac{\frac{1}{12} + \frac{1}{30}}{\frac{17}{80}} = \frac{28}{51}
 \end{aligned}$$
