

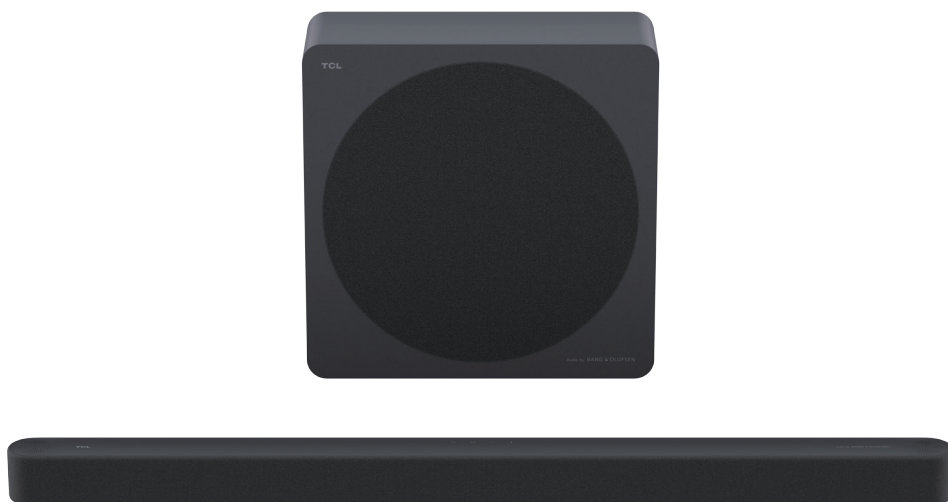

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Before You Begin

- Carefully read and observe all safety instructions in the safety leaflet.
- This Sound Bar is intended for indoor use only. In case it accidentally gets in contact with small amounts of water, unplug immediately and use a dry cloth to remove the water.
- Unplug the Sound Bar if it is not used for long periods of time or during lightning storms.
- Make sure the Sound Bar is installed on a solid surface or solidly wall-mounted below your TV for the best experience.
- Only use AAA 1,5V non-rechargeable batteries for the Remote Control.
- In case any of the cables are visibly damaged or pinched, unplug the Sound Bar and replace the cable.
- Be careful not to bend the HDMI cable excessively to avoid affecting performance.
- Protect your hearing by adjusting to a proper volume. Predefined and customizable sound settings are available for your listening comfort.

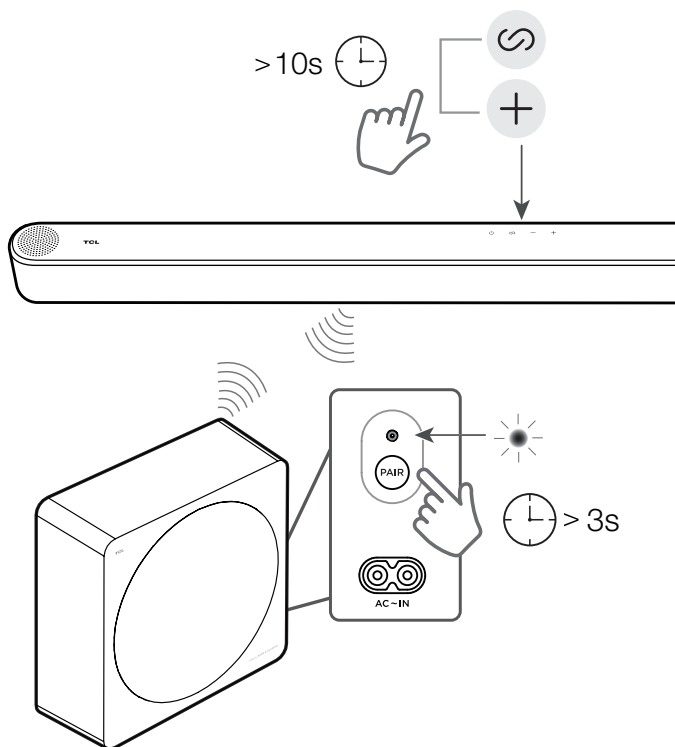

Note:

- Factory reset: Press and hold , , and on the sound bar panel simultaneously for 10 seconds until the LED display shows "FACTORY RESET", then the device will automatically restart.
- View version: While the device is powered on or in standby mode, press and hold and on the sound bar panel for 10 seconds, or press , , and on the remote control (please follow the sequence and keep the interval within 2 seconds).
- Automatic standby switch: In the powered-on state, press and hold the and on the remote control simultaneously for 10 seconds. If this function is enabled, the sound bar will enter an automatic standby state after 20 minutes without signal input.

Overview of the Wireless Subwoofer



Wireless Subwoofer

Short press  to enter standby mode or turn on the device.

THE SUBWOOFER HAS BEEN PAIRED WITH THE SOUND BAR UPON FIRST USE.

In case of a problem, take the following steps to manually pair:

1. Press and hold  on the subwoofer for 3 seconds until the indicator light above it flashes rapidly to enter pairing mode.
2. Long press  and  on the sound bar panel together for 10 seconds until the LED display shows "SUB PAIRING" on the sound bar.
3. When pairing is successful, the indicator light on the subwoofer turns solid, and the sound bar LED display will show 'SUB CONNECTED'.

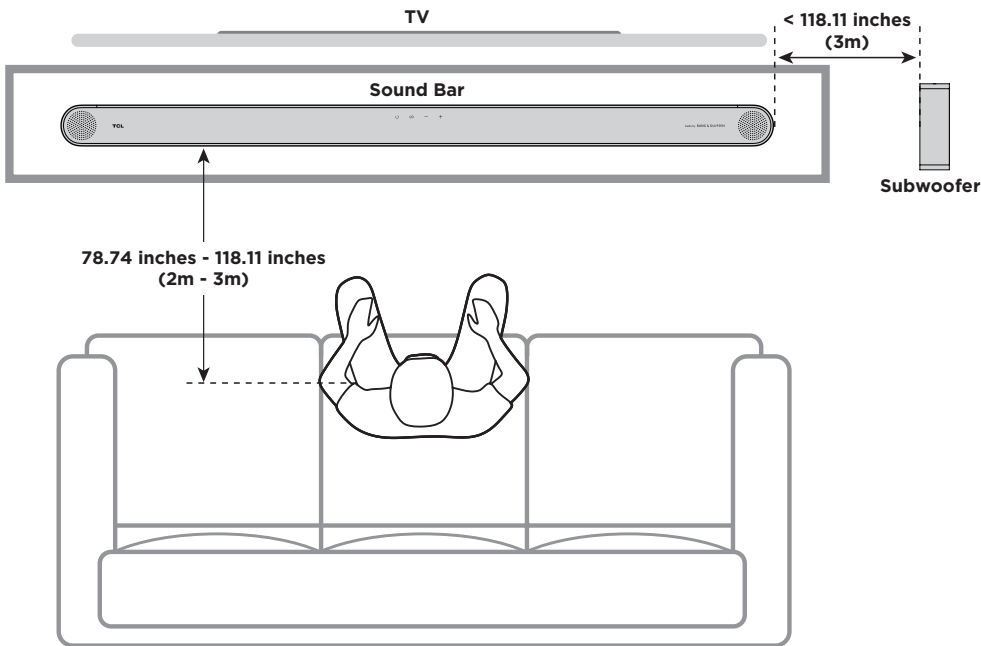

- Additional tools (not supplied) are required for installation.
- You can choose to place your Sound Bar below the center of your TV or mount it on the wall.

Position Your Sound Bar and Subwoofer

It is recommended to place the sound bar directly below the TV. Please refer to the figure below for the positioning of the sound bar and subwoofer.

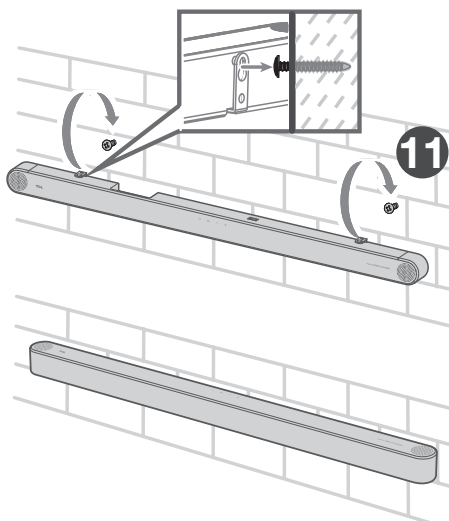
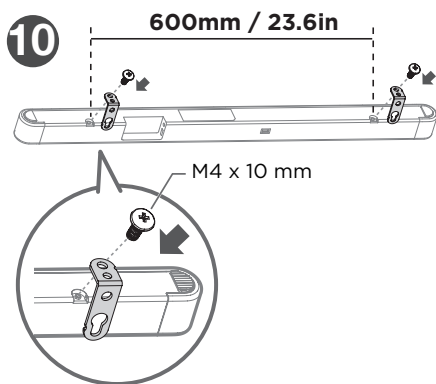
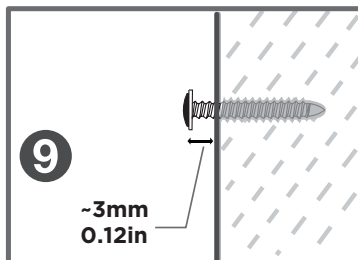
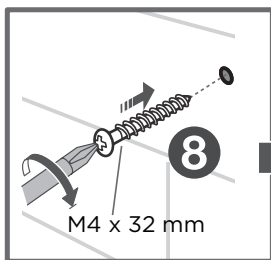
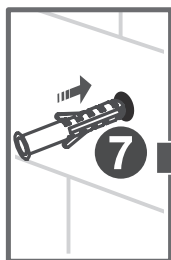
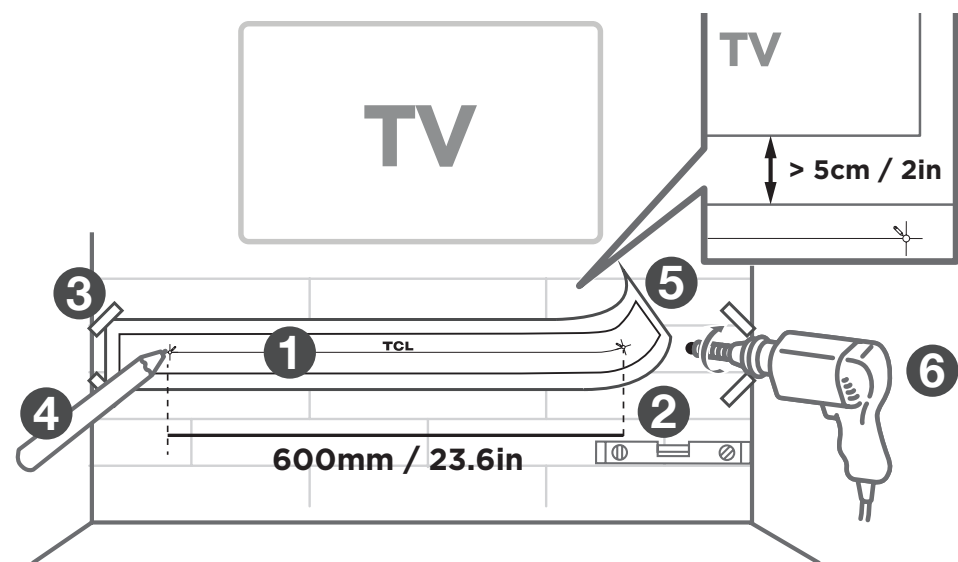
Note

- Do not place the sound bar in direct sunlight, high temperatures, open flames, or humid environments. Suitable mounting height: < 78.74 inches/2 meters.

Method A: Flush Wall Mounting

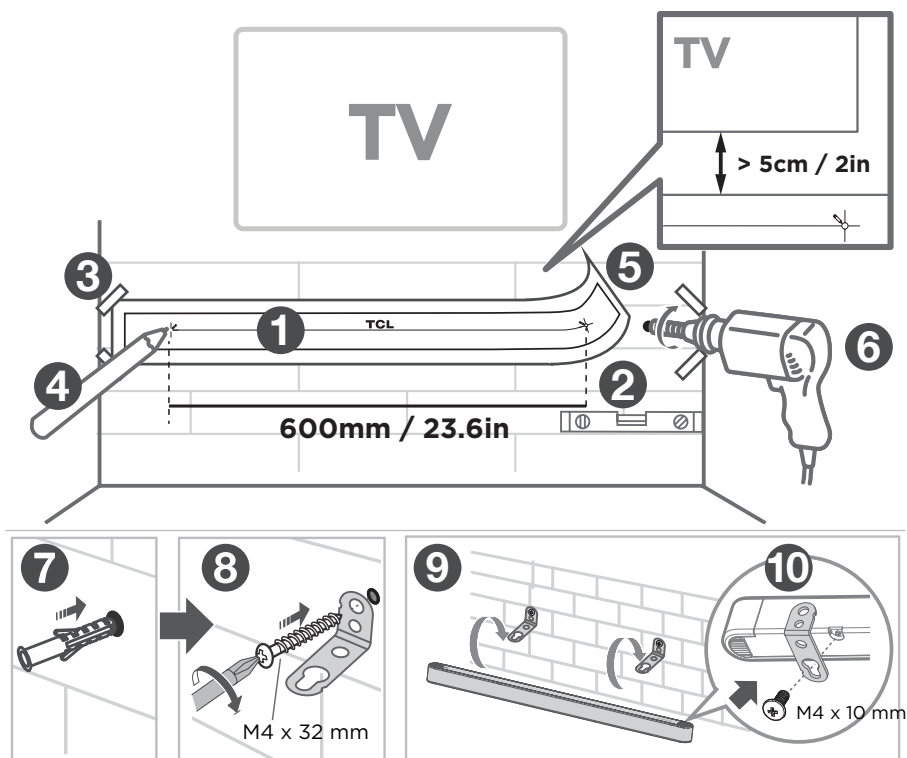
For flush wall mounting, it is recommended to use a suitable USB extension cable (not included) for USB playback (the exposed length of the plug after insertion must be ≤ 0.236 inches/6mm).

1. Place the supplied wall mount template on the wall. Make sure the wall mount template is at least 2 inches/5cm below the center of the TV.
2. Use a level to check if the wall mount template is positioned correctly.
3. Securely tape the wall mount template to the wall.
4. Mark the installation holes on the wall through the template.
5. Remove the wall mount template.
6. Drill a screw hole at each marking on the wall with a depth of 1.22-1.3 inches/31-33mm.
7. Insert the wall anchors into the holes on the wall.
8. Insert the supplied screws into the drilled holes.
9. Tighten the screws, leaving a gap of about 0.12 inches/3mm between the screw head and the wall.
10. Attach the wall mount brackets to the back of the sound bar. Then insert the supplied screws into the brackets and tighten them.
11. Lift the sound bar and hang it onto the screws on the wall, similar to hanging a picture. Ensure all parts are securely seated.



Method B: USB Connection (The inserted USB drive must not protrude more than 1.06 inches/27mm from the back of the sound bar to prevent it from pressing against the wall).

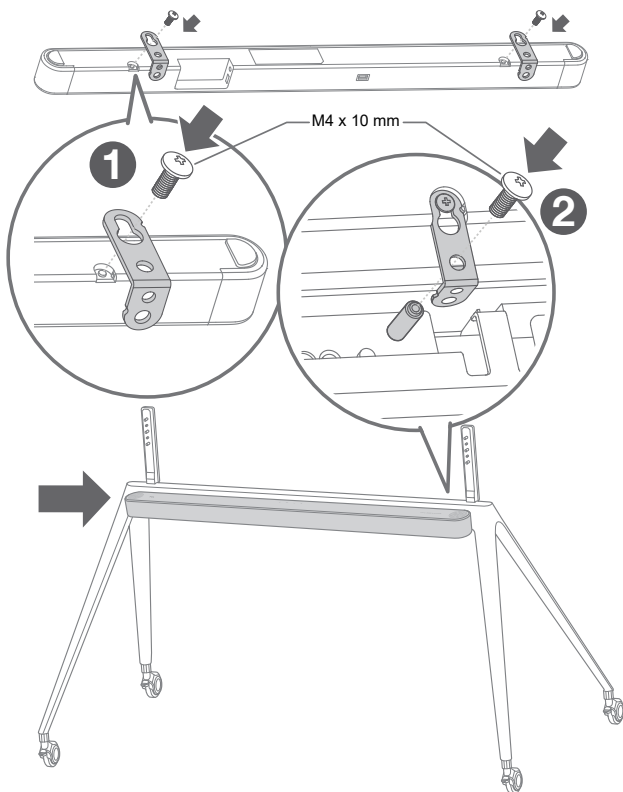
1. Place the supplied wall mount template on the wall. Make sure the wall mount template is at least 2 inches/5cm below the center of the TV.
2. Use a level to check if the wall mount template is positioned correctly.
3. Securely tape the wall mount template to the wall.
4. Mark the installation holes on the wall through the template.
5. Remove the wall mount template.
6. Drill a screw hole at each marking on the wall with a depth of 1.22-1.3 inches/31-33mm.
7. Insert the wall anchors into the holes on the wall.
8. Insert the supplied screws through the wall mount brackets into the drilled holes, then tighten the screws to secure them.
9. Lift the sound bar and hang it onto the wall mount brackets.
10. Insert the supplied screws into the wall mount brackets and tighten them.



Movable Stand Mounting

1. Slot a screw through the holes on the bracket (x2) and tighten the screws (x2) into the sound bar.
2. Hang the sound bar on the moveable floor stand. Slot a screw through the holes on the bracket (x2) and tighten the screws (x2) into the moveable floor stand.

Note: The stand is sold separately.



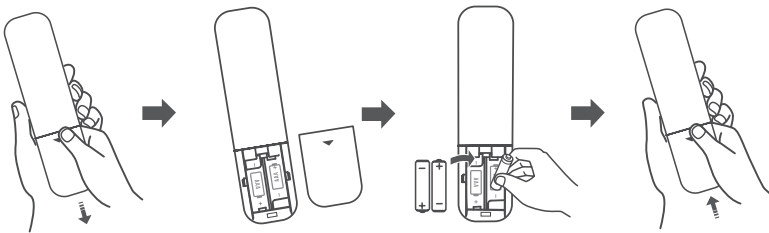
Install/Replace the Remote Control Batteries

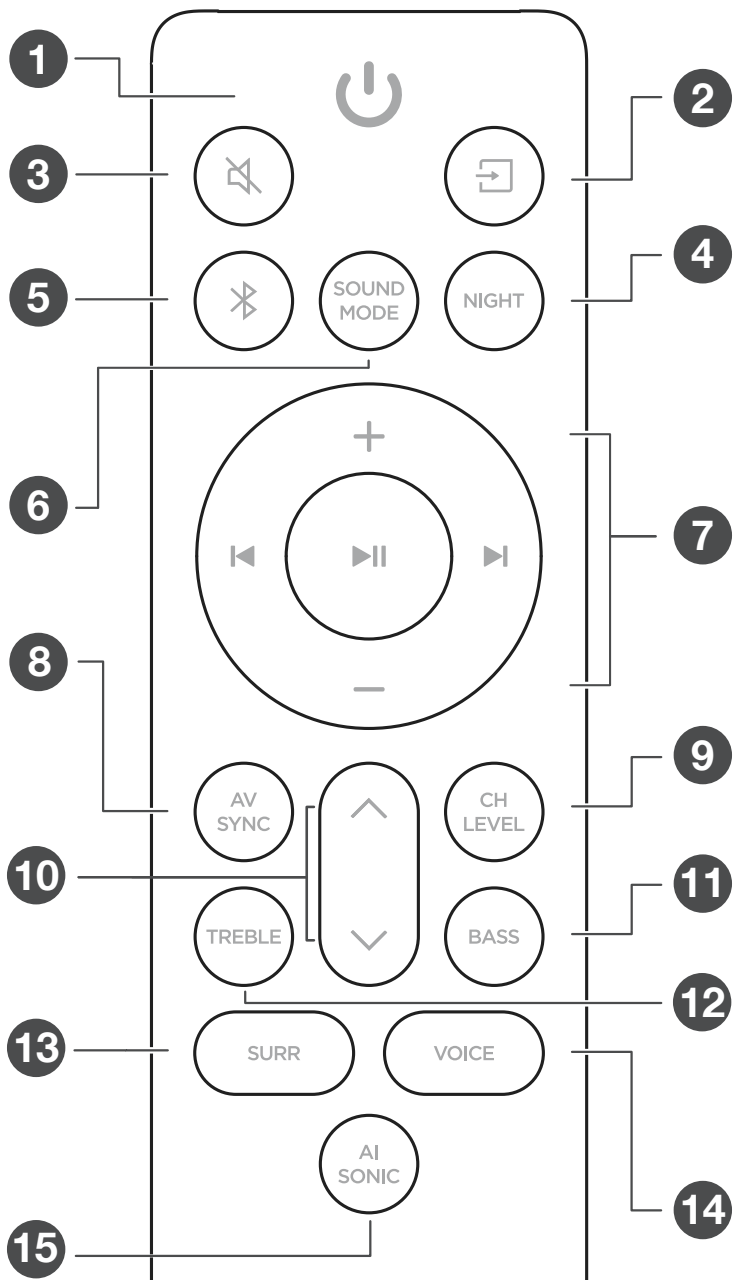

 - 2 Place two new AAA batteries into the battery compartment with the correct polarity (+/-).
 - 3 Close the battery compartment.

Overview of the Remote Control



- ① Short press: Power on/power off
Long press: Power off
- ② Short press: Switch input sources (HDMI eARC/USB/Bluetooth)
- ③ Short press: Mute/unmute the sound
- ④ Short press to switch the sound mode to Night Mode. Long press for more than 3 seconds to cycle through the LED display brightness: Level 1 (100%) / Level 2 (70%) / Level 3 (40%). Default: Level 1.
- ⑤ Short press: Select bluetooth mode
Long press: Bluetooth pairing
- ⑥ Short press: Switch sound mode Standard/Movie/Music/Voice/Game/Night/Sports/Custom (Custom mode includes adjustments for Voice Enhancement and Surround Enhancement)
- ⑦ + Increase volume
- Decrease volume
⏮ Play previous music
⏭ Play next music
⏸ Short Press: Play/pause music.
Long press ▶▶ to wake up the LED Display and scroll to display "Source®+Audio Format®" info twice.
Press and hold this button when paused or stopped, and "Source®" will be displayed for two cycles only.
- ⑧ Short press to wake up the LED display, then use the Up/Down buttons to adjust the Audio Delay within a range of 0 to 300ms.
- ⑨ Short press to switch between Center Level, Front Top Level, and Subwoofer Level. Then short press the Up/Down buttons to adjust the volume.
- ⑩ The Up/Down buttons can adjust: Sound Mode (and Custom), AV Sync, Channel Level, Treble, Bass, and AI SONIC.
- ⑪ Short press to enter Bass adjustment mode, then short press the Up/Down buttons to increase or decrease the bass.
- ⑫ Short press to enter Treble adjustment mode, then short press the Up/Down buttons to increase or decrease the treble.
- ⑬ Press  to switch to Custom. Press  to select, then use the Up/Down buttons to adjust the effect (High, Mid, Low, or Off).
If the sound mode is not set to Custom, pressing  will display 'ONLY FOR CUSTOM SOUND MODE' on the LED Display.
- ⑭ Press  to switch to Custom. Press  to select, then use the Up/Down buttons to adjust the effect (High, Mid, Low, or Off).
If the sound mode is not set to Custom, pressing  will display 'ONLY FOR CUSTOM SOUND MODE' on the LED Display.
- ⑮ Short press to enter AI Sonic-Adaptation. Then short press the Up/Down buttons to switch between user-defined AI Sonic-Adaptation: Position 1/Position 2/Position 3/Off (Must be configured in the APP to take effect).

After you have fixed the position of the Sound Bar, you can start connecting it to your TV or other devices and listen to the audio through your Sound Bar. Make sure you have muted the audio of your TV or device. For information, check the user manual of your TV or device.

Connect with the HDMI Cable

Note

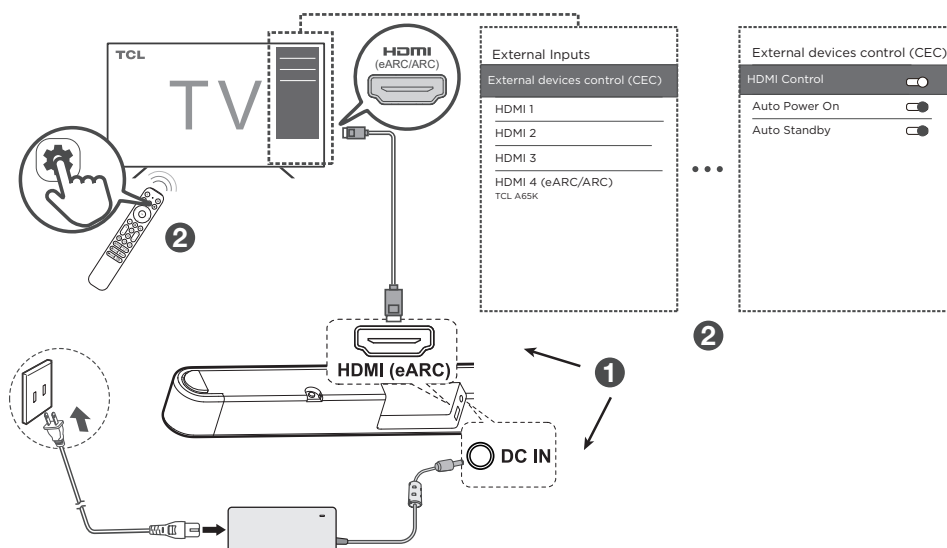
- Make sure your TV or device supports the HDMI (eARC/ARC) feature. For information, check the user manual of your TV or device.

Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI (eARC) input port on the soundbar, and the other end to the HDMI (eARC/ARC) output port on the TV or other device.

To get the best possible audio experience using the HDMI cable, follow below given steps:

For TCL TV:

- 1 Connect the HDMI cable from the HDMI (eARC) port on the soundbar to the HDMI (eARC/ARC) port on the TV.
- 2 Enable the CEC function in the settings of the TCL TV. (See TV User Manual for instructions)

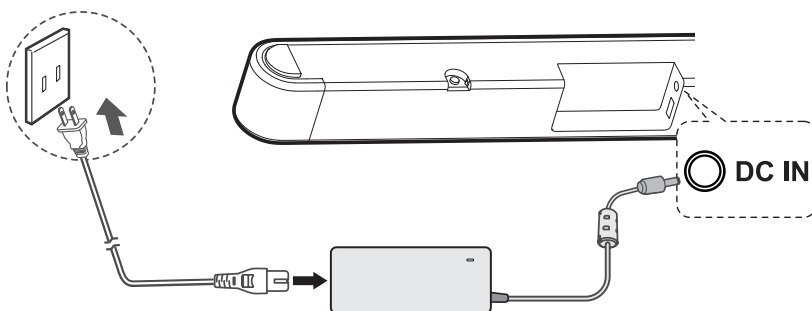


- ★ The name of the CEC (Consumer Electronics Control) feature may vary by TV brand. This feature may be known as CEC, Anynet+, SIMPLINK, BRAVIA Sync, EasyLink, or VIERA Link. For more information, please refer to your TV user manual.

The method for enabling this feature varies by TV brand.

Connect Your Sound Bar to Power Supply

- 1 Make sure that you have completed all other connections before connecting the Sound Bar to power supply.
- 2 Make sure the power supply voltage complies with your country's safety standards (see 'Specifications' on page 27)
- 3 Connect one end of the provided power cord to the DC input power connector on the sound bar, and the other end to a wall outlet.



Connect the Sound Bar to Your Bluetooth Device

Notes

- Make sure your wireless device supports the Bluetooth function.
- The operational range between the Sound Bar and your Bluetooth device is approximately 10 meters (without any obstacle between the Bluetooth device and the Sound Bar).

1. Press the .

2. Method A: Long press  on the remote control.

Method B: Short press the  button on the sound bar to switch to the Bluetooth source, then long press  for 3 seconds to enter Bluetooth pairing mode. The LED display will show "PAIRING". The sound bar is ready to pair.

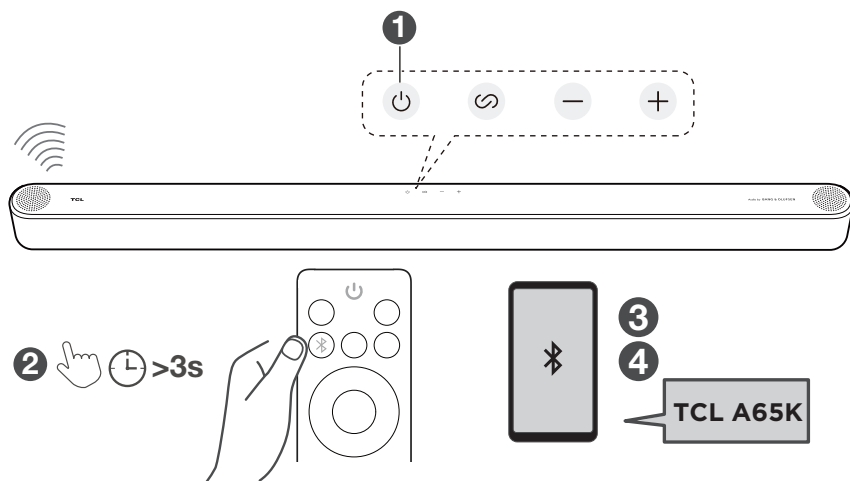
3. Turn on your Bluetooth device and ensure it is in pairing mode.

4. Select "TCL A65K". The LED display will show "BT CONNECTED". Pairing is successful.

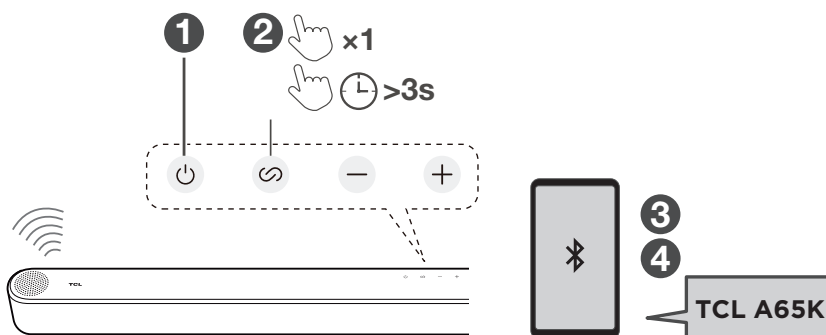
5. Repeat step 3 to pair other Bluetooth devices.

Tip

- If you cannot find the model name **TCL A65K** on your Bluetooth device, press and hold  on the Remote Control. The LED display will show "PAIRING". Now the Sound Bar is coming into the pairing mode.

Note: After powering on your Sound Bar, if there is no operation performed on either the Sound Bar or Remote Control within 10 seconds, all LED indicators on the Sound Bar will turn off and light up again when the operation is resumed.

Listen to Music from Your Bluetooth Device

- 1 Make sure that your device supports A2DP and/or AVRCP. For information, check the specification of your device.

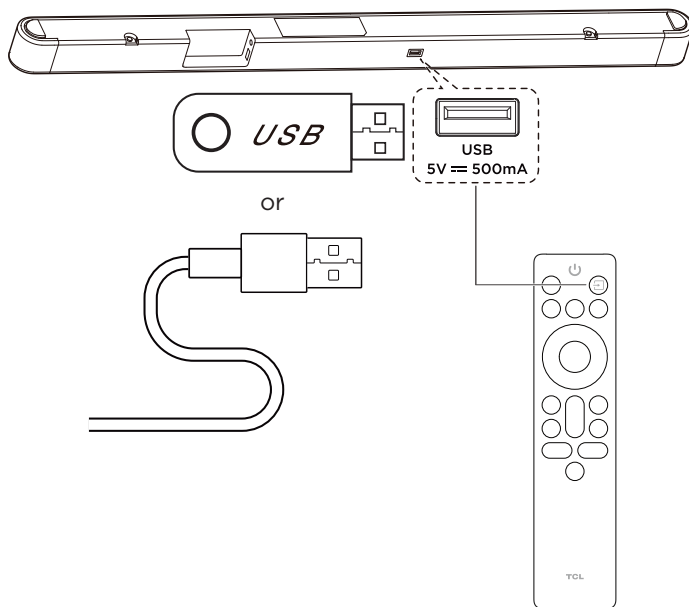
- 2 Pair your Bluetooth device with the Sound Bar (see 'Connect the Sound Bar to Your Bluetooth Device' on page 21).
- 3 Start listening to music stored in your Bluetooth device through the Sound Bar.
 - If your Bluetooth device supports A2DP, you can listen to music, but you cannot control the playback.
 - If your Bluetooth device supports AVRCP, you can listen to music and control music playback with the Remote Control. Short press play/pause button to pause or resume music playback. Short press left/right button to skip to the previous/next track.

Note

- The operational range between the Sound Bar and your Bluetooth device is approximately 10 meters (without any obstacle between the Bluetooth device and Sound Bar).

USB Music Playback

- Press play/pause button on the Remote Control to listen to/pause/resume the music.
- Press left/right button on the Remote Control to skip to the previous or next track.
- Press the Volume +/- buttons to increase or decrease the volume.



Tip

- This sound bar supports USB drives up to 128GB (FAT/FAT 32). Supported file formats: MP3, WAV, FLAC.
- Music files should be stored within 5 folder levels. Otherwise, the sound bar cannot detect the music.

Software Update

TCL may offer updates for the Sound Bar's system firmware in the future.

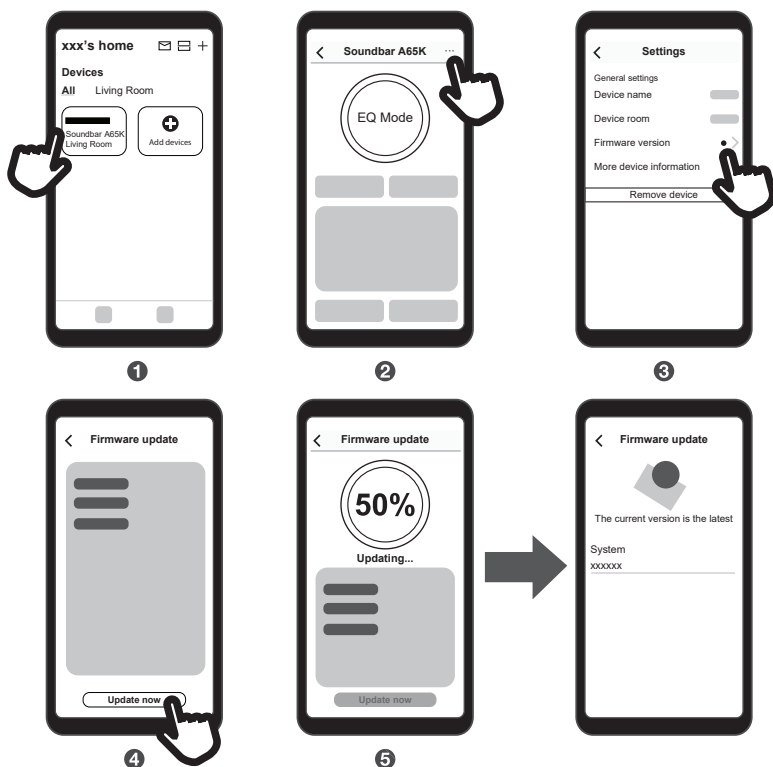
When an update is available, you can upgrade the Sound Bar by connecting the USB drive or using TCL HOME app to update the firmware online.

Online Update

Follow the instructions in the image below to update the firmware on TCL HOME app.

Note

- Information displayed on the App may vary depending on the mobile device.
- Ensure the subwoofer is connected to the sound bar before updating.
- Do not operate the sound bar or subwoofer, or exit the TCL HOME app during the update process.
- Update duration may vary depending on the firmware version. The LED display will show "SUCCESS" if the update is successful, and "FAILED" if it fails.
- If the App update is too slow, please contact TCL customer support or use the USB update method.



USB Update

Requirements:

- TCL Sound Bar
- A computer connected to the Internet
- A USB storage device in FAT/FAT32 format with at least 100MB of available space.

Note: Please remove all files and folders from the USB storage device (it should be empty).

Update Procedure:

- A. Find your device model on the TCL support website and download the latest update file for the TCL sound bar.
- B. Move or copy the file with the ".fw" extension to your USB storage device.
- C. Update the TCL sound bar by following these steps:
 - Step 1: Unplug and reconnect the power cord, then restart the sound bar.
 - Step 2: Switch the sound bar to USB mode and insert the USB storage device.
 - Step 3: The system will update automatically; you can monitor the update status via the sound bar LED.
 - Step 4: The sound bar will restart automatically once the update is complete. The entire process takes about 5 minutes. After the update is finished, please remove the USB storage device from the sound bar.

Important:

1. During the update process, do not remove the USB storage device, unplug the power cord, or turn off the sound bar.
2. If the update fails, the LED display will show "FAILED". Please unplug the power cord and the USB device, then repeat the above steps to retry the update.
3. Before upgrading, please make sure that all sources are not physically connected.
4. Before updating, please ensure the subwoofer is connected.
