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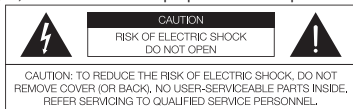
1 Before you begin

- Carefully read and observe all safety instructions in the safety leaflet.
- This Sound Bar is intended for indoor use only. In case it accidentally gets in contact with small amounts of water, unplug immediately and use a dry cloth to remove the water.
- Unplug the Sound Bar if it is not used for long periods of time or during lightning storms.
- Make sure the Sound Bar is installed on a solid surface or solidly wall-mounted below your TV for the best experience.
- Only use AAA 1,5V non-rechargeable batteries for the Remote Control.
- In case any of the cables are visibly damaged or pinched, unplug the Sound Bar and replace the cable.
- Be careful not to sharply bend the HDMI and optical cable as they may affect the performance.
- Protect your hearing by adjusting to a proper volume. Predefined and customizable sound settings are available for your listening comfort.

Overview of the wireless Subwoofer



Wireless Subwoofer

THE SUBWOOFER WILL PAIR AUTOMATICALLY WITH SOUND BAR UPON THE FIRST USE. In case of a problem, take the following steps to manually pair:

1. Press and hold the  button on the Subwoofer for 3 seconds until an amber light begins flashing on the  button.
2. Press and hold the  button on the Sound Bar for 10 seconds until the LED display shows “SETUP PAIR” on the Sound Bar.
3. After a short while, the Subwoofer LED will turn solid. The Subwoofer is now connected to the Sound Bar.

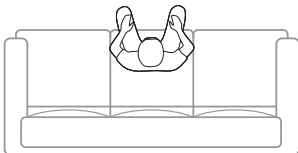
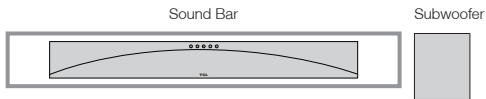

Position Your Sound Bar and Subwoofer

The ideal place to position the Sound Bar is centered underneath your TV.

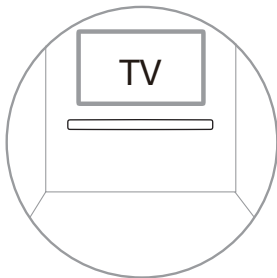
You are recommended to place the Sound Bar on the top of the cabinet and right below the center of your TV.

The distance between the Subwoofer and the Sound Bar should be less than 9.8'.

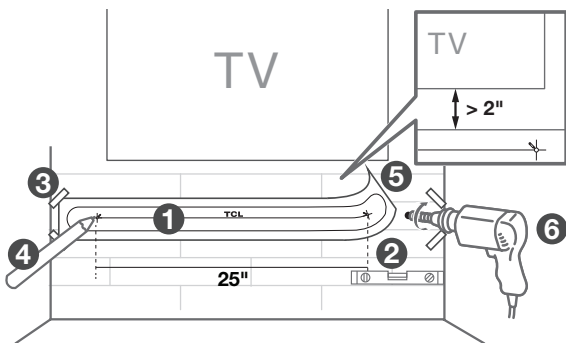


Mount your Sound Bar on the wall

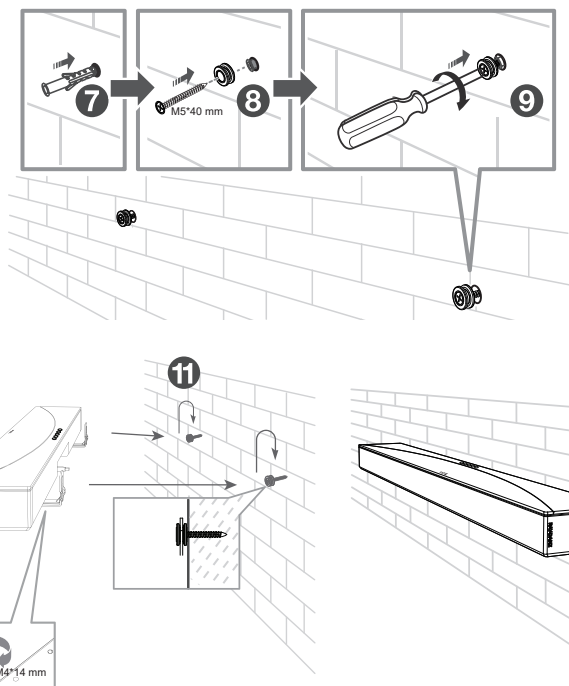
- 1 Place the supplied wall mount template on the wall.
Make sure the wall mount template is at least 5cm below the center of the TV.
- 2 Use a level to make sure the wall mount template is positioned accurately.
- 3 Use tape to adhere the wall mount template firmly on the wall.



- 4 Locate the mounting holes on the template and mark the wall.
- 5 Remove the wall mount template.
- 6 Drill a screw hole at each marking on the wall.



- 7 Insert the wall anchors in the holes on the wall.
- 8 Insert the supplied screws with the wall brackets into the hole of the wall anchors.
- 9 Tighten the screws into the wall.
- 10 Place the bracket and tighten the screw.
- 11 Pick up the sound bar and attach it to the wall screws, similar to how you would hang a picture. Make sure everything is tight.



Notes

- Do not place your Sound Bar in a location exposed to direct sunlight, heat, fire, or moisture. Only suitable for mounting at heights: < 78.7”.

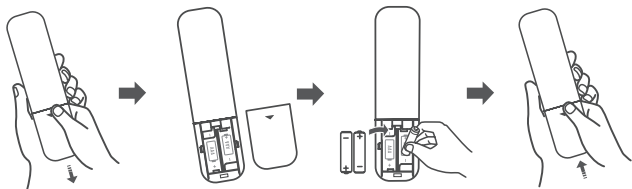

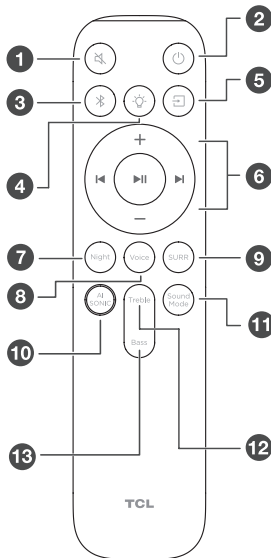

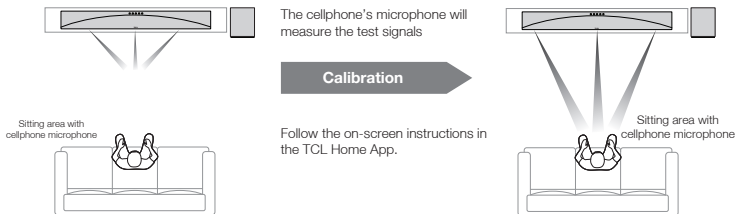

After you have fixed the position of the Sound Bar, you can start connecting it to your TV or other devices and listen to the audio through your Sound Bar. Make sure you have muted the audio of your TV or device. For information, check the user manual of your TV or device.

Connect with the HDMI cable

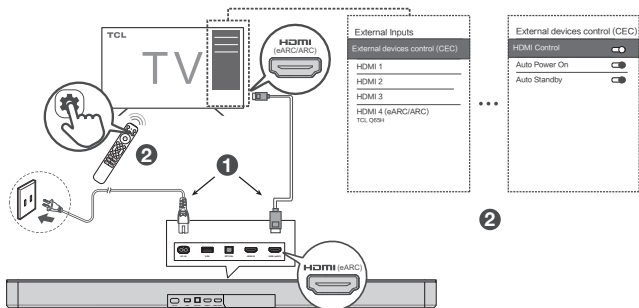
- Make sure your TV or device supports the HDMI (eARC/ARC) feature. For information, check the user manual of your TV or device.

Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI eARC input connector on your Sound Bar and another end to the HDMI (eARC/ARC) output connector of your TV or device.

To get the best possible audio experience using the HDMI cable, follow below given steps:

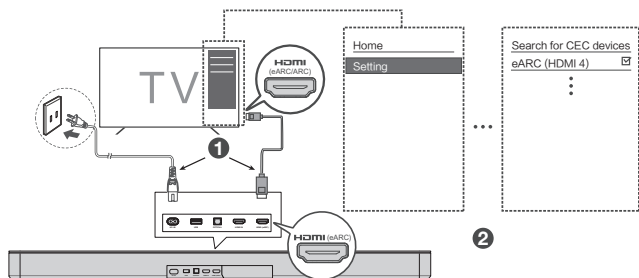
For TCL TV:

- ① Connect HDMI cable from the HDMI (eARC) interface on the Sound Bar to the HDMI (eARC/ARC) interface on the TV.
- ② Enable the CEC function in the settings of the TCL TV. (See TV User Manual for instructions)



For other TV brands:

- ① Connect HDMI cable from the HDMI (eARC) interface on the Sound Bar to the HDMI (eARC/ARC) interface on the TV.

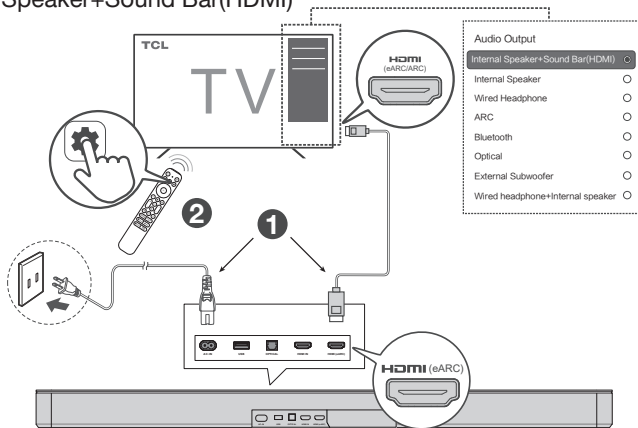

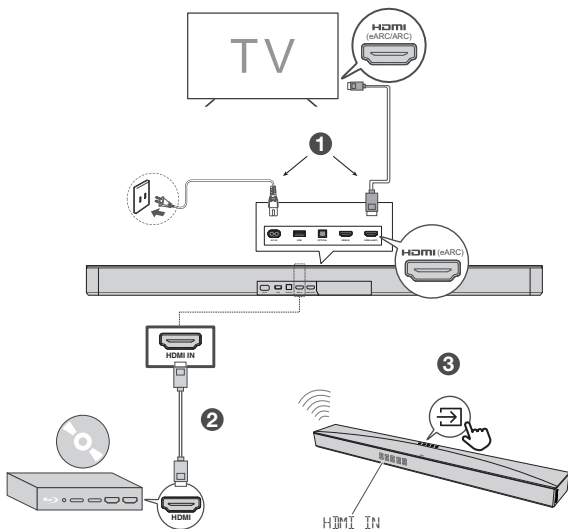

HDMI IN (Connect and play audio from the external devices)

- 1 Connect HDMI cable from the HDMI (eARC) interface on the Sound Bar to the HDMI (eARC/ARC) interface on the TV.
- 2 Use another HDMI cable to connect the sound bar's HDMI IN interface to your external devices (e.g., blu-ray).
- 3 Switch the Sound Bar source to "HDMI IN".

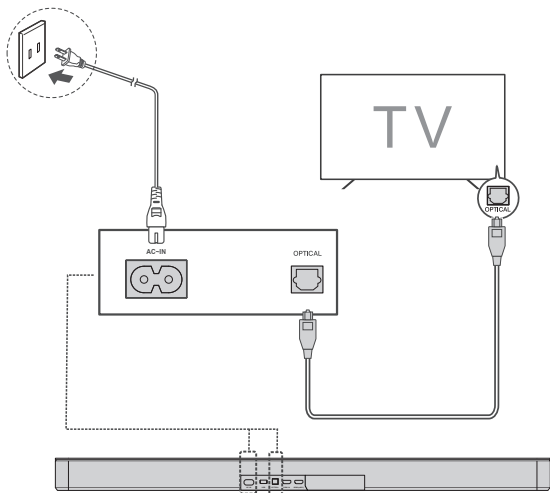
Note:

- Make sure to use high-speed HDMI cables that support the required audio/video formats.



Connect with the optical cable

- 1 Remove the protective caps from the optical cable when necessary.
- 2 Connect one end of the optical cable to the optical input connector on your Sound Bar and another end to the optical output connector of your TV or device.



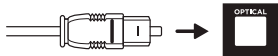
Note

- If there is no sound output from the Sound Bar, try to activate the PCM signal output on your TV or device. PCM is used to convert analog audio signals into digital audio signals in most devices. For more information of how to activate the PCM signal output, check the user manual of your TV or device.

Direction for setting up your Sound Bar using an optical cable



Do not bend or kink the optical cable (SPDIF) as it is fragile and can easily get damaged and broken.



To get the best possible audio experience using the optical cable:

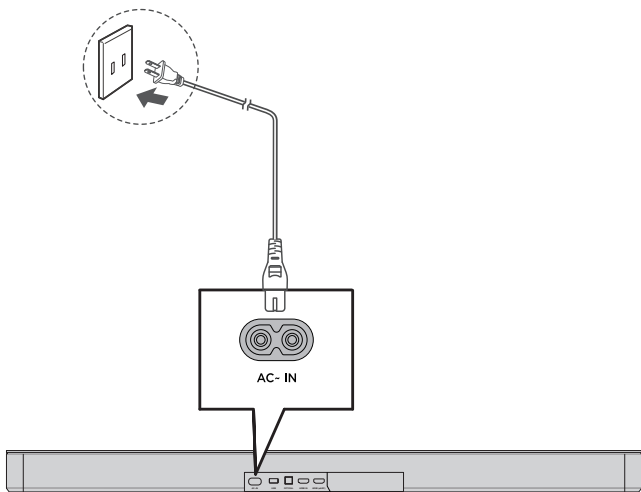
- 1 Press the Home button on your TCL TV Remote.
- 2 Navigate to **Audio option** under **Settings**.
- 3 Change the TV settings so that the sound of the TV can be output from the speaker system. Depending on your TV, this may be set automatically when the speaker system is connected. Refer to the operating instructions of your TV.

Notes

- *Different devices may have different menu options.*
- *Devices such as Blu-ray players, set-top boxes, etc. are also applicable.*

Connect your Sound Bar to power supply

- 1 Make sure that you have completed all other connections before connecting the Sound Bar to power supply.
- 2 Make sure the power supply voltage complies with your country's safety standards (see 'Specifications' on page 37)
- 3 Connect one end of a supplied AC power cord to the AC input connector on your Sound Bar and another end to the power socket on the wall.

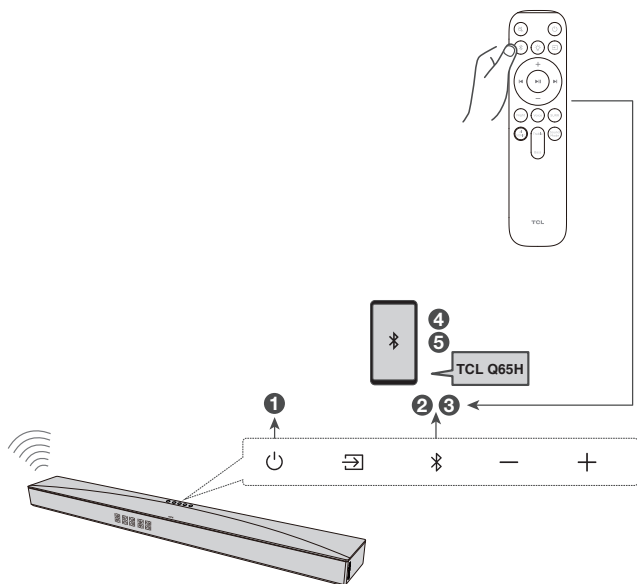

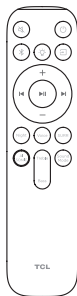

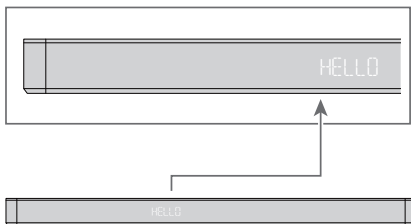

- 1 Make sure the Sound Bar is properly connected to the power supply and sources.
- 2 Press  at the top panel of your Sound Bar or Remote Control to switch to the correct source.

Listen to music from your Bluetooth device

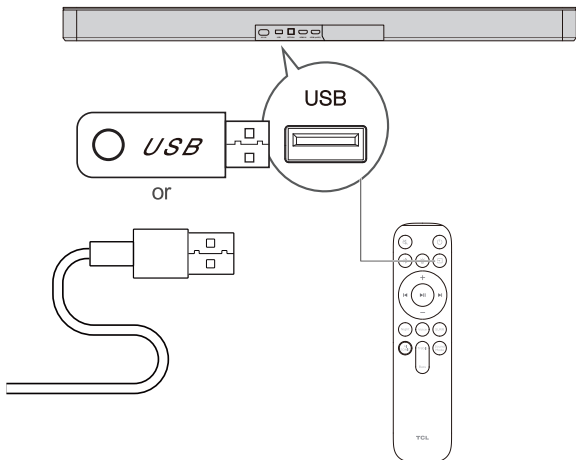
- 1 Make sure that your device supports A2DP and/or AVRCP. For information, check the specification of your device.
- 2 Pair your Bluetooth device with the Sound Bar (see 'Connect the Sound Bar with your Bluetooth device' on page 29).
- 3 Start listening to music stored in your Bluetooth device through the Sound Bar.
 - If your Bluetooth device supports A2DP, you can listen to music, but you cannot control the playback.
 - If your Bluetooth device supports AVRCP, you can listen to music and control music playback with the Remote Control. Press the center button to pause or resume music playback. Press left/right button to skip to the previous/next track.

Note

- The operational range between the Sound Bar and your Bluetooth device is approximately 10 meters (without any obstacle between the Bluetooth device and Sound Bar).

Use the USB cable or device for music playback

- Press play/pause button on the Remote Control to listen to/pause/resume the music.
- Press left/right button on the Remote Control to skip to the previous or next track.
- Press up/down button to increase or decrease the volume level.



Tip

- This Sound Bar can support USB devices of up to 128GB memory and the supported file format is MP3, WMA, WAV, FLAC.
- Music in folders of the USB device should be within 5 (including 5) directory levels. Otherwise, the Sound Bar can not detect the music.

5 Software update

TCL may offer updates for the Sound Bar's system firmware in the future.

When an update is available, you can upgrade the Sound Bar by connecting the USB drive.

USB update

Requirements:

- TCL Sound Bar
- Computer connected to the Internet
- A USB storage device formatted in FAT/FAT32 with at least 100MB of free space.

Note: Please remove all the files and folders from the USB storage device (after that it should be empty).

Update Procedure:

- A. Find and download the latest update file for your TCL Sound Bar on TCL support web (www.TCL.com -> Support). It is VERY important to use the correct file for your specific model.
- B. Move or copy the downloaded file to your FORMATTED and EMPTY USB storage device. Once completed, the file named “.UPG” should be the ONLY file located on the USB storage device.
- C. Upgrade the TCL Sound Bar using the following steps:
Step 1: Unplug and reconnect the power cord, then restart the Sound Bar.
Step 2: Switch the Sound Bar to USB mode and plug in the USB storage device.

Step 3: The system will automatically upgrade and you can understand the updates process by the Sound Bar LED.

Step 4: The sound bar will restart after the updates completed, the whole process of the update will take approximately 3mins. Please REMOVE the USB storage device from the Sound Bar after the upgrade completed.

IMPORTANT:

1. During the update process, DO NOT remove the USB storage device, unplug the power cord, or turn off the Sound Bar.
2. The LED display shows "UPG FAIL" if the upgrade is not successful, please unplug the power cord and the USB device then repeat the above steps to upgrade the Sound Bar again.
3. Before upgrading, please make sure that all sources are not physically connected.
4. Before upgrading, please make sure that the subwoofer is connected.

No sound

- Press up button to increase the volume level.
- Make sure the Sound Bar is not muted.

Low voice

- Use the Remote Control to adjust the volume.

The Remote Control does not work.

- Make sure you have selected the correct source.
- Make sure the distance of Remote Control and the Sound Bar is within operational range.
- Make sure the battery is correctly inserted and is working.
- Make sure the Remote Control is close to the Remote Control sensor of the Sound Bar.

I hear distorted sound.

- Make sure all cables are properly connected.
- Make sure you have selected the correct source.
- Make sure the TV is muted if you play audio from the TV.

I cannot find the Bluetooth name of this Sound Bar on my Bluetooth device.

How to pair Subwoofer with Sound Bar?

- Press and hold the  button on the Subwoofer for 3 seconds until an amber light begins flashing on the  button.
