Adjusting the water softening system *

Ask your water supply company what the water hardness is and enter this...


* Only before the first wash or if the water hardness has changed

Water-hardness value °dH	Hardness range	mmol/l	Setting value
0 - 6	Soft	0 - 1.1	H:00
7 - 8	Soft	1.2 - 1.4	H:01
9 - 10	Medium	1.5 - 1.8	H:02
11 - 12	Medium	1.9 - 2.1	H:03
13 - 16	Medium	2.2 - 2.9	H:04
17 - 21	Hard	3.0 - 3.7	H:05
22 - 30	Hard	3.8 - 5.4	H:06
31 - 50	Hard	5.5 - 8.9	H:07


How to adjust

- ⚡ Switch on the ON/OFF switch
- Press **setup 3 sec.** button for 3 seconds.
- The display shows **Hxx** and **set**
- Press the Start button until the correct water hardness level is set.
- To store the settings, press the **<** button for 3 seconds.




Add special salt

Dissolves limescale (not necessary when set to 0!) ...




Open the lid.




Only fill the salt dispenser with water before the first wash.


For optimal washing results



Add special salt (never use detergent!).




Close the lid. Rinse immediately.



Add rinse aid


Gets it sparkling clean ...




Press marking 1,

For optimum drying results




Add rinse aid.






Overview of programmes

This overview describes all the possible programmes. You can see which programmes your appliance offers from its control panel. The values given in the programme details are laboratory measurements compliant with European standard EN 60436. The consumption figures depend on the selected programme and additional functions. The programme duration will be different if the machine is short of rinse additive or the function is turned off.

- Pull out the mains plug.
- Remove filters and scoop out water.
- Lever off cover (A).
- Check area around the fan impeller for foreign objects.
- Click cover shut (B).
- Insert filters.



Fault

Possible causes

Remedy

Display E32 / -00
and lights up



Water supply not connected

- ▶ Supply fitting open.
- ▶ 1. Unscrew water connection.
2. Clean filter in the water supply.
3. Flow rate must be min. 10 l/min.,
when water supply is open.
If the flow rate is less, replace the supply fitting.
- ▶ Install supply hose without kinks.
- ▶ Connect water supply.
(Drinking water connection in the instruction manual).

Display E92 / -40

Filters are soiled or blocked

- ▶ Clean the filters (see above).

Display E61 / -03
and lights up

Waste water hose is blocked or kinked

- ▶ Reposition the waste water hose without kinks.

Cover of waste water pump not fitted

- ▶ Attach cover (see above).

Display E61 / -02
and lights up

Waste water pump blocked

- ▶ Clean waste water pump (see above).

Other error display
Exx / -xx lights up

Appliance technically defective

- ▶ Call the after-sales service
(name the fault display).
- ▶ Unplug the appliance.

Residual water in the
appliance

Programme has not yet ended

- ▶ Close the appliance and switch it on
or terminate the programme
(see Terminating the programme).

Rust on cutlery

Cutlery not rust-resistant
Hard knife blades are more susceptible
External rack

- ▶ Use dishwasher-proof cutlery.
- ▶ Never wash rusting parts in the appliance.


Fault

Possible causes

Remedy

Tableware is not clean

Sand or gritty residue
on the tableware



Tableware lies against one another
or on top of each other

Not enough detergent

Unsuitable programme selected

Spray arm nozzles are blocked

Filters are contaminated, not firmly seated

Spray arms blocked

- ▶ Separate tableware,
prevent contact points.

- ▶ Follow the manufacturer's instructions (detergent).

- ▶ Select a more intensive programme

- ▶ Clean spray arms (see above)

- ▶ Clean the filters (see above).

- ▶ Arrange tableware so that spray arms
can rotate freely.

Spots and streaks

Rinse aid dosage too high / too low

- ▶ In the case of streaks: reduce detergent dosage.

- ▶ In the case of water or limescale marks:
increase dosage.

Tableware not dry

Rinse aid

- ▶ Increase dosage.
Change product.

- ▶ Use rinse aid.

Milky deposits on
the tableware
(removable)

The combined detergent used
has a poor drying performance.
Appliance setting

- ▶ Activate intensive drying (depending on model).

Milky deposits,
glasses clouded / opaque
(cannot be removed)

The water softening function
is wrongly configured
Insufficient special salt

- ▶ Configure water softening system

- ▶ Add special salt

Glasses not dishwasher-proof

Plastic / tableware items
discoloured

- ▶ Use dishwasher-resistant glasses.

- ▶ Use glass-protective cleaners.

Not enough detergent
Discolouration by food dyes
(tomato sauce)

- ▶ Follow the manufacturer's instructions (detergent).
- ▶ Discolouration will not damage the appliance;
fade after further wash cycles.

Cancel the programme ...



All displays light up,
then "0:01" appears in the display
"0:00" appears after the programme has finished

Load the appliance correctly ...

During the programme,
press the button for
approx. 4 sec. (reset).

Insert dishwasher-proof tableware (roughly remove large remnants of jam,
dairy products and meals without leaving residue from ash, wax,
lubricating grease, paint, adhesive labels) as described in the instruction manual
and check that the spray arms can rotate freely
