- Accurate spelling, grammar and punctuation;
- Good organisational skills and the ability to self-motivate;

It is not essential that you have prior experience however it is desirable that you have an existing blog/work that we can review.

SALARY

Payment varies from meeting to meeting depending on the agreement we have with the organiser. The minimum will be a £55.00 per diem and we will also book your travel and hotel arrangements (with breakfast) if required.
