# Description

The ground, which is L shaped and light filled ACCOMMODATION to the rear with numerous roof lights, benefits from planning permission for restaurant use. The premises is in shell condition, and includes a disabled WC. also benefits from a rear exit which leads to a shared side exit onto Thomas Street. A separate store is available which is ideal as a bin store. There is a basement which could be used a store or the access could be removed to increase the ground floor space.

There is planning consent in place for a new shop

The upper floors, has independent access onto Thomas Street, includes 4 generous bedrooms on the first and second floors, all of which include an ensuite WC and shower. The top floor has a kitchen/living room to the rear and the front room could be an additional bedroom or living space.

Given the challenging residential rental market and staffing environment, the property offers a truly unique opportunity to lease a premises with full planning for restaurant on the ground floor while also securing a 4/5 bedroom residence for staff.




# Location


# 72 Thomas Street occupies an enviable location on Thomas Street close to its junction with Francis Street.
