Set in the tranquil countryside of Ballyfoleen South, Kilfinny, Adare just a short drive from Adare Village, this impressive site offers a rare opportunity to restore and extend a traditional dwelling, constructed in the early 1800's; supported by full planning permission and a carefully considered architectural vision.

The site comprises of 3.21 acres of top quality limestone land and offers both heritage features and modern development potential, fully approved for a substantial home and garage.


The house is approached through a private entrance and a long avenue and enjoys a sheltered setting with scenic views over the gardens and surrounding countryside.

This serene setting is nestled between the 'Oldcourt Stream' which winds around the Eastern boundary of the site and 'Lismoylan Ringfort' which is adjacent and included in the property on the Western boundary. The property includes many mature trees and an old Orchard.



















## **Proposed Interior 3D**









## Outbuildings, Courtyard and Ringfort:

To the rear of the residence is a Courtyard with a selection of old stone out buildings incorporating a Storage Shed a Hen House, Stables and Cow house.

Planning has been granted to convert these buildings into a modern garage including three additional storage rooms.

The property has two large paddocks to the front, either side of the driveway avenue, comprising of c. 3 acres, large enough to keep a number of animals.

The property comes with a unique feature- 'Lismoylan Ringfort'. The ringfort is proof the site was settled almost 1,000 years ago.
