

Welcome to Inishlounaght Way, elegant homes, built to the highest standards





This development comprises of a selection of 6 different house types with a variety of 3,4 and 5 bedroom detached and semi-detatched homes. Each house is a superbly built, architect designed family home, both modern and luxurious in its finish.

The superb Inishlounaght Way will see each home built on an elevated site with amazing panoramic views over the stunning surrounding countryside within the magnificent idyllic village setting of Marlfield, Clonmel, Co. Tipperary.





Inishlounaght Way takes into consideration comfort, luxury and modern contemporary living. We at JSF Homes pride ourselves in providing for you the most modern, efficient, superbly finished and professionally built homes possible. Each home is highly insulated to achieve and maintain thermal comfort with a high level of air tightness to retain heat. All our homes include Air to Water energy efficient heating, a Heat Recovery Ventilation system and underfloor heating throughout. Our superior Inishlounaght Way homes are designed and built to achieve a BER A2 Rating. The heating system is zoned to allow you to manage your energy needs with ESB smart meters installed in each of these homes. Category LD2 fire alarms systems are installed in each house.



The village Marlfield lies just three kilometres west of Clonmel. The townland of Marlfield replaced an older settlement near the 12th century Cistercian community of Inislounaght Abbey. Nearby St Patricks well - Traditional history links the site with Saint Patrick who proselytised Ireland in the 5th century. From the 12th to 16th centuries, St. Patrick's Well belonged to the nearby Inishlounaght Abbey.

Marlfield is steeped in history and was developed as a minor regional industrial centre using water from a tributary of the river Suir as a source of power, it had the largest grain mill of its time in the country, the local lake was constructed to run the mill machinery. There were several grain and rapeseed mills situated near the lake which were superseded by a substantial distillery, which was eventually taken over by Jamesons before it closed. Marlfield house, former residence of the Bagwell family, was built in 1785. It was badly damaged by fire in 1923 and was subsequently re-built and remains an integral part of Marlfield to this day.

Experience the blend of village charm within easy access to all the facilities of a large town close by. Inishlounaght Way, Marlfield lies approximately three kilometres from the town of Clonmel with local daily transport services available and has easily accessible driving routes in and out of the town. Clonmel, with a population of over 18,000 is home to several multi-national companies including the medical, beverage and pharmaceutical industries. The town offers a choice of many retail outlets and is home to a selection of quality hotels, restaurants, cafes and bars. Educational facilities on offer include a choice of creches, primary schools, secondary schools, (including the prestigious Rockwell College nearby), and also third level options. Clonmel lies within easy reach of Cork (97km), Limerick (80km), Dublin(188km). The local Bus and Train Station provide links to all the larger cities and indeed towns closer to home.


amazing views over stunning countryside within easy access to all amenities.



Energy Efficiency

All homes are BER A2 rated and incorporate sustainable and renewable technology resulting in lower energy costs. Our homes are constructed to provide a high level of airtightness in order to retain heat and include an air to water heat pump system which is thermostatically zone controlled to maximise your comfort, there is also a Heat recovery unit throughout and underfloor heating on ground and 1st floors. Each home is fitted with a smart 24hr ESB meter and will have a provision made for an EV charging point.

Additional House Features

JSF Homes will complete each house to a builder's finish – allowing the purchaser to install their own choice of flooring, tiling, and lighting fixtures. These two storey homes include a solid wooden step and handrail stairs with a choice of solid timber internal doors, skirting boards and architraves are fitted as standard. White Sanitary ware is installed, toilets, sinks, showers in bathroom and en-suite. All bathroom's floors and walls are provided un-tiled. All electrical wiring is in place for pendant lighting.





Low Maintenance Exteriors

Inishlounaght Way detached Homes are low maintenance with a tasteful mix of brick and render exteriors. All driveways are finished to allow for 2 car spaces. Back Gardens will have a lawn seeded and will come with a finished patio area. Most houses will also have a front lawn area seeded.
