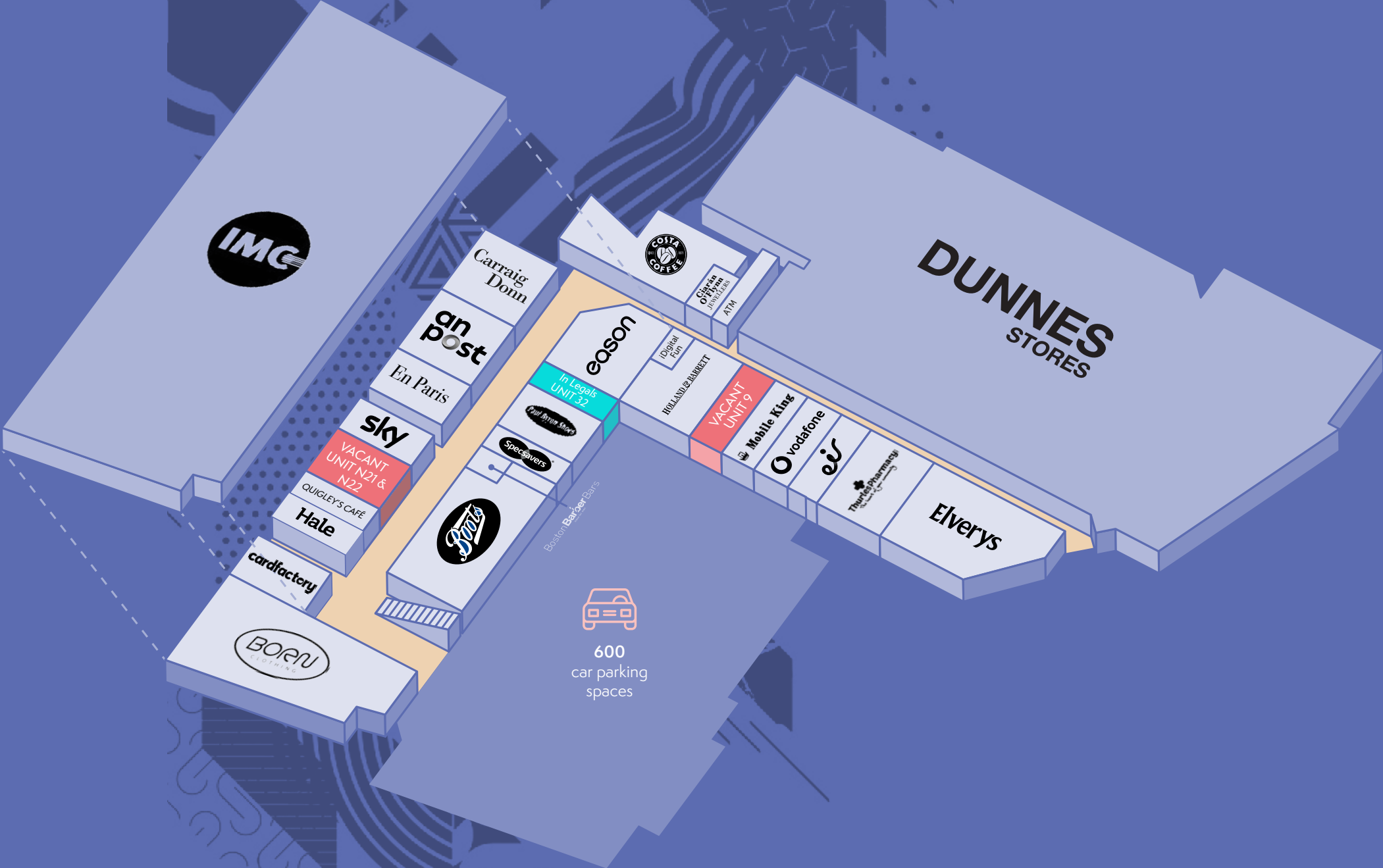


CATCHMENT AREA
