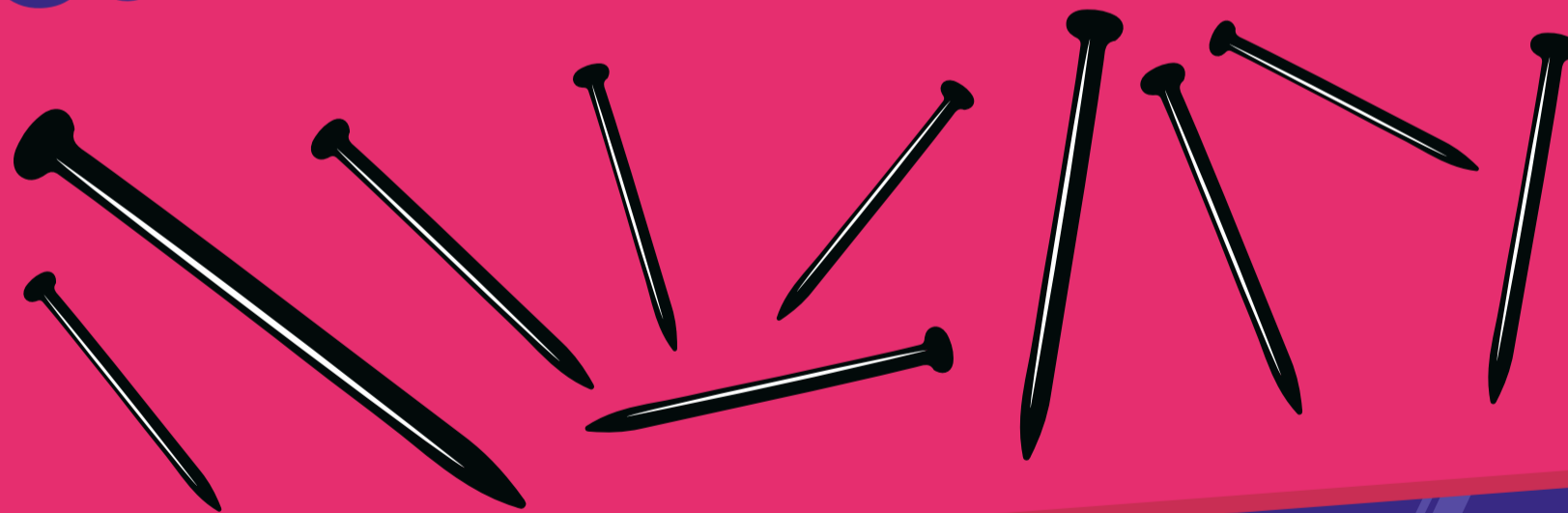

The workshop

Modual is an interdisciplinary creative workshop that, since 2014, has taught collaborative and digital skills to UAL students.

At Modual, we partner with some of the best art and design organisations from across the UK and beyond, providing students with the opportunity to immerse themselves in a professional creative studio set-up. For Modual: Maker, we are partnering with London Design Museum and taking inspiration from their Designer, Maker, User exhibition.

The workshop

Modual: Maker is an opportunity to collaborate with students from across UAL to design and create innovative products that, broadly, aim to make the world a better place.

Participants will work in interdisciplinary teams to explore new ideas and technological possibilities, before developing and pitching their final projects to an audience of industry experts.



Who can apply?

All UAL students, including postgraduate students are invited to take part.

In addition, students participating in the GDI workshop at Central Saint Martins are invited to apply for Modual: Maker. This includes students studying at:

Who should apply?

We think anyone and everyone with an interest in the creative arts should join Modual, and try to make sure that as many people have the opportunity to participate as possible.

Our aim is to make Modual a fun, yet challenging, experience and welcome students with a range of different experiences, educational backgrounds and outlooks on life.

That said, Modual will be of particular interest to students wanting to get a taste of what it's like to work in the creative industries, start a design studio or launch an arts project.

Who should apply?

Modual is an interdisciplinary collaborative workshop, so bring an open mind, expect to work together and prepare to learn new skills!

Modual is not so good for people with a fixed idea of what they want to do, or who are looking to develop in-depth specialist knowledge.



What do I need to bring?

An open mind and your creativity!

In addition, a laptop, tablet or smartphone will be useful.

We'll provide all other materials, pens, paper and refreshments throughout the workshop.

Support will be provided by industry experts and the Modual team. Some budget and other resources will also be provided. No prior experience or specific skills are necessary.

Participants are responsible for making their own way to the Design Museum and are expected to be able to attend every day of the workshop.

The Commitment

Modual: Maker is a two week workshop. The Modual process is intensive and therefore we ask participants to attend every day from 10am - 5pm. If you are not fully available for the full two weeks of the workshop then unfortunately you will not be able to take part in this workshop.

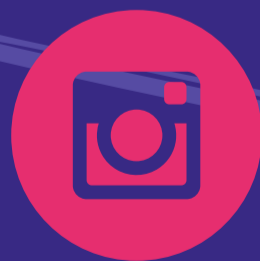
