

### **HTM FS Optional MODBUS Module**

#### **General Description**

The Hybrid Thermal Mixing (HTM) system from Monodraught is designed to provide natural ventilation, hybrid ventilation (incorporating mixed tempered air for winter periods), secure night time cooling and boosted levels of ventilation during summer. The HTM FS systems are designed to work in conjunction with natural ventilation and can be used in single sided and cross flow ventilation strategies.

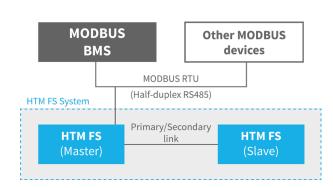
The MODBUS module allows a HTM FS system to be installed on to a MODBUS RTU network and make visible a number of system variables to the master MODBUS device.

#### **Technical Details**

The MODBUS module for HTM FS plugs into the Control Board and interfaces with the on-board microcontroller to provide MODBUS RTU visibility of the HTM FS system over a half-duplex RS485 link.

Each HTM FS system has its own unique MODBUS number allocated 1 to 247 within the configuration header of the HTM FS. HTM FS units are usually linked in a Primary/Secondary configuration to form one system. In this instance the Primary unit will collate the information from the Secondary unit and present the collated information on the MODBUS network.

The MODBUS module requires a 1.5 or 2 pair shielded cable daisy chained between each of the Modbus modules located in the Primary units. Cable is to be supplied and installed by others.

## MODBUS **DETAILS**



### **Wiring Requirements**

MODBUS RTU over RS485 (Half-Duplex) connection wiring as follows:

- A 1.5 or 2 pair shielded cable (nominal characteristic impedance 120 Ohms, such as a Belden 9842 cable or Alpha Wire 6413) daisy chained between each of the modbus modules located in the master units. Cable to be supplied and installed by others.
- Shield to only be terminated at one end.
- Use spare conductors for GND reference connection, as long as there will be low ground currents. For high ground differentials, please use an isolator.
- Units at the ends of the daisy-chain to have  $120\Omega$  terminators (this can be enabled on the module using the DIP switches).

# MODBUS **DETAILS**

#### (†) FAULT\_CODE Object Values Description

The FAULT\_CODE object is a numeric value that indicates any fault present on the system. Each fault has a unique code allocated to it (2(n-1) where n is the fault number) which are added together to form the FAULT\_CODE. So if there was a fault with the SD card, UI and MVHR, the fault code would be 21(1+4+16).

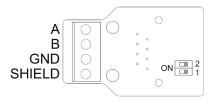
