

Reopening of the Musée Yves Saint Laurent Paris Thursday, October 8, 2020



After a long period of closure due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Musée Yves Saint Laurent Paris is delighted to reopen on Thursday, October 8, 2020.

Until further notice, the museum will be open from Thursday through Sunday, from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

In order to limit the number of visitors, your ticket – which will show the date and hour you must arrive at the museum – must be reserved in advance via the museum's website: museeyslparis.com.

In order to ensure everyone's safety, the reopening of the museum will adhere to strict health measures we have put in place.

New health measures for visitors

- The museum is open from Thursday through Sunday, from 11:00 a.m to 6:00 p.m.
- Reservation in advance via the museum's website museeyslparis.com is required.
- A limited number of visitors in the exhibition rooms.
- Coatroom closed.
- Hands must be disinfected with hydroalcoholic gel available at the museum entrance. Additional hydroalcoholic gel dispensers are available throughout the exhibition.
- A mask must be worn by all visitors over 11 years of age throughout the museum, during the entire visit.
- Social distancing between you and other visitors and museum personnel must be respected.
- New signage throughout the museum will remind the public of the health measures that must be respected.
