This song was the fourth to be released from Beyoncé's third album: *I Am... Sasha Fierce*. It won best song at the 2009 MTV Music Awards and also a Grammy in the same year.

Bogard and Tedder apparently wrote the song in around three hours in Tedder's home studio whilst he was injured and had to stay in the house. Later, when in the studio to record the track, Beyoncé was responsible for writing the melody and bridge in the song.

There was some controversy around this song, as Simon Cowell claimed that it was originally intended for Leona Lewis. Writer Ryan Tedder says it was always intended for Beyoncé but had tentatively offered the song to Lewis if Beyoncé didn't record it.

The album title introduces what Beyoncé refers to as her performing alter-ego, Sacha Fierce, whom she describes as strong, sassy and sexy but says: "I'm not like her in real life at all... what I feel onstage I don't feel anywhere else".

Beyoncé is married to rapper and producer Jay-Z. She and her husband are friends with President Obama and his wife, Michelle. Beyoncé says Michael Jackson is her main musical influence: "if it wasn't for Michael Jackson, I would never have performed". Whitney Houston, Mariah Carey and Lauryn Hill have also influenced her. She tours with an all female band known as the Suga-Mamas who have played with her during most of her live performances since 2006. She is said to have a vocal range of about four octaves.

She has won a wealth of awards during her career including: one BRIT award, 20 Grammy awards, one Ivor Novello award and six MOBO awards. Beyoncé and Adele jointly hold the record for most Grammy awards won by a female artist in one night: six.
