The equipment list is just a recommendation and it is possible that I have forgotten something. Group equipment required (possible to borrow from Idrottsveteranerna, contact for availability):

- Tents
- Stoves and fuel
- Shovels (preferably one for each two participants)
- Wind sacks
- Tape for feets
- Sunblock
- Pack of extra batteries for headlights

Personal equipment:

- Backpack, preferably +75 litres
- Plastic lining for backpack waterproofing
- Winter sleeping bag
- Winter sleeping mat (please avoid inflatable sleeping mats)
- Thermos at least 2 litres
- Personal water bottle carried on body 0.5 litres
- Headlight
- Plastic spoon
- Compass
- Sunglasses

Personal clothing:

Layer one:

- Thin socks, 2 pairs (wool preferably)

- Thin gloves
- Balaclava/buff
- Functional underclothing, 2 pairs (long t-shirt)
- Functional underclothing (long underwear)

Layer two:

- Socks second layer, 2 pairs minimum
- Warm sweater
- Outdoor pants
- Gore-tex jacket (or its equivalent)
- Gore-tex pants (or its equivalent)
- Skiing gloves
- Skiing cap/hat

Layer three:

- Down jacket (or its equivalent)
- Warm hat
- Warm gloves

Idrottsveteranerna will bring a first aid kit, one GPS and provide maps for all participants.

Food:

 Freeze dried 24 hours field rations are available for purchase from Idrottsveteranerna, cost of approximately 250 SEK/USD 30 per person and day (make contact for availability in due time)

Fuel:

Gas, propane/butane and kerosene is available for purchase from Idrottsveteranerna,
cost of approximately 100 SEK/USD 12 for 230g propane/butane and 100 SEK/USD
12 for 1 liter gas/bensin (make contact for availability in due time)
