

PM FOR ÖRESUNDSSPELEN 3-5/7 2026

All competitors, leaders and relatives are warmly welcomed to this year's Öresundsspele which includes just over 600 participants who together makes about 1400 entries. Participating nations are Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland, Germany and Qatar.

Starting bibs etc. can be collected in the competition office at Hedens IP, in the blue house.

Friday, July 3: 15.00 – 19.30

Saturday, July 4: 09.30 – 18.00

Sunday, July 5: 09.30 – 18.00

All participants must wear their number tag fully visible on their chest when competing. In high jump and pole vault it is allowed to wear it on the back.

Prizes/award ceremony: Award ceremony is held after each final competition. Placement 1-3 receives a prize. For overcoming a Öresundsspel record, a special plaque is obtained. In the age group 11 years and younger, everyone gets a medal - an honorary medal per participant - not per branch.

Dressing room and toilets: Will you find in the Green house on the north side of the stadium.

Warm up: General warm up is outside the stadium, see map. Warm up should not occur on the inner stadium. Only those who are participating in an ongoing competition is allowed on the inner stadium.

WE ASK ALL LEADERS AND ACTIVE TO RESPECT THIS.

Confirmation of participation: In all running disciplines, you must confirm your participation no later than 60 minutes before assigned start time. You do that via easyrecord.se. ADJUST ANNUAL BEST in all races for proper seeding. You get your heat and track number during the calling, 10 minutes before the race. This conformation will not be needed in the jumping and throwing events.

Post-registration is received by the secretariat, subject to availability.

Calling: In all disciplines at each competition site 10 min before start. Monitor your starting order.

Races: There will be no finals in races longer than 110 m, the result will depend on the times in the separate heats. The competitors are divided into heats depending on their best time; the best time runs in the last heat, the second best in the second last heat, etc., therefore, it is important that best times are stated.

Races up to and including 110 m are settled by best times going to final. A- and B-final is held if more than 24 is participating. The times in the different finals are not merged.

If it turns out that qualifying round is not needed after the confirmation of participation, in races, the final will be held immediately on the trial time!

Finals in technical events: In all technical disciplines the 8 best will go to the finals and get 3 more attempts. The results of the trial follow with the participants to the finals.

Competitors 11 years and younger: everyone has 4 attempts in all technical events. They race twice at 60m, once in the morning and once after lunch.

Own equipment's in throwing events: These must be submitted and weighed in at least one hour before each event starts in the material shed. The in-weighed tools may be used by all competitors in the branch.

Spike length: 6 mm in running branches and 9 mm in jump / javelin
