COOKIE POLICY (this policy forms part of our Privacy Policy)

Information about our use of cookies by the my-e-coach Personal Development Platform (the Platform)

Mye-coach Ltd uses cookies to distinguish you from other Members using our Services. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you use our Services and allows us to improve our site. By continuing to access and use our Services, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer or other hard component of any device that you use to access our Services ("Device") if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to reside on your Device. You can stop this happening (usually by adjusting the settings function of your Device).

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of the Platform. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of the Platform or make use of the Services or Documents.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how users move around the Platform when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way the Platform works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to the Platform. This enables us to personalise content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region if and to the extent that such functionality exists on our Services).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to the Platform, the areas you have visited and the links you have followed. We may use this information to make the Platform and the material displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information (which is anonymous) with third parties for this purpose.

Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies

You can block cookies usually by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our Service.
