Option 2: AFTERNOON NICOSIA WALKING TOUR

'Cosmopolitan, cultural, glamorous and bustling, the capital of Nicosia is uniquely comprised of an ancient, walled city and a modern, fast-paced metropolis that is the epicenter of the island's business and commercial activity.'



As we stroll around the narrow streets of old Nicosia, we will pass through **Laiki Yitonia**, a recently restored 19th quarter of the city with Taverns and Craft shops. The tour continues to **Leventis Museum**. The Museum was created to present and highlight the history of Nicosia, the last divided capital of Europe. It narrates the history of the city from prehistoric times to the present day through its exceptional, rich Collections. More than 10,000 objects, including maps,



documents, paintings, engravings and costumes, present moments of the centuries-old history of the city and invite visitors to interact with its past. Afterwards we will have the opportunity to see the **Ledra Checkpoint**, which is one of the 9 checkpoints on the island in total, that divide the Island of Cyprus into two parts, the Republic of Cyprus with the self-proclaimed state occupied by the Turkish Forces from 1974 to this day.
