Lunch is served in Soweto in a Local Shebeen (please note that on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday lunch will most likely be served at an alternative restaurant in Soweto, due to most Shebeens being closed)

TOUR ITINERARY

After collecting you from your hotel or residence in Johannesburg, your guide will give you a quick pre departure tour briefing before departing to Soweto (South Western Township)

On our way to Soweto we pass by the National Football Stadium City, which hosted the opening and closing ceremonies of the World Cup 2010. We enter the Diepkloof area, where we will take a walk past vendors selling just about anything. In Orlando West we visit Vilakazi Street- drive past the former home of Nelson Mandela and past the home of Archbishop Desmond Tutu. You will have an opportunity to read about the Soweto uprising on 16 June 1976. On that tragic day an innocent little boy called Hector Pieterse gave up his life and kick-started the liberation of South Africa. During this tour, we will pass by the Mandela House. A visit into the museum is optional.

We continue our tour driving into one of the shanty towns where you get to interact with some of the locals.

By now you will have seen the good, the bad and the ugly facets of Soweto. We drive past the Soweto Campus of the Johannesburg University and end our tour with a view of the largest hospital in the world: Chris Hani Baragwanath Hospital.

Apartheid museum

After Lunch in Soweto we visit the world famous Apartheid Museum. Here you will learn about the history and struggle of South Africa during apartheid.
