Regional judging

Team of judges go through each nomination and choose their regional finalists.



Regional celebration

All the regional finalists are invited to celebrate - getting to this stage is a massive achievement!



National judging

From the list of regional finalists, a winner and runner up is chosen for each category. These are the national finalists.

Filling out your nomination

Before you start your nomination

You will need:


- Full name of the person you are nominating Which award category your nomination fits into
- The name of the service/team this person works in
- Their region and Managing Director
- Your reasons for nominating the person







- Community Team of the Year
- Care Home Team of the Year
- Specialist Team of the Year
- Branch of the Year
- Community Support Worker of the Year
- Care Home Support Worker of the Year
- Field Based Support Team Member of the Year
- Group Support Team Member of the Year
- Group Support Team of the Year
- Community Manager of the Year
- Care Home Manager of the Year





There are also special awards up for grabs on the night, chosen by the selection panel!





Nominee

The person you want to win an award

Testimonial

A message from someone who works with or has been supported by the person you are nominating. This could be from a family member, external professional or person we support.

External professional

Someone from outside of Voyage Care who can speak highly of your nominee. E.g. a social worker or Care Manager

Judge

A member of the selection panel who will help to decide the nominations that are successful.

Nomination

The form you fill in that tell us all about your nominee and why they should win.



Judge's top tips



Give examples - always give specific examples to back up your reasons for nominating.



Think about what the nominee has done that's special and the positive impact they have had on the people they support.



Time - make sure you give yourself plenty of time to write a high quality nomination



Stand out - remember the judges have a lot of nominations so be clear why your nominee has gone above and beyond



You have 300 words - use them! The more detail you can give, the better.



"When writing your nomination, keep your explanations clear and to the point while ensuring there is enough information for the selection panel to make their decision. The panel won't know anything about the fantastic work that the person you are nominating has done and can only take into consideration what they are reading."
