

How can you prepare for your exam?



1. Dedicate time each day to revise for your assessment. Set yourself a target to learn a few lines each day. Put your phone on silent and concentrate on learning!

Create - activity builder - printable worksheets - gap fill - copy and paste your assessment (1 paragraph at a time) - highlight key words - then complete the activity! - This will help learn each paragraph initially. Challenge - change the words / increase the number of gaps to make it harder! Keep doing the activity and it will help!

3. Card sort - write your sentences on a piece of card - cut up each sentence - your challenge is to put them in the right order! When you know the order you can cut up words/phrases and have to put your paragraph together! Challenge - time yourself! See how quickly you can do it!

4. Ask for help! Get a brother/sister/parent/carer/boyfriend/girlfriend/teacher to help you! Languages teachers are always willing to help so bring your work. You can use the computers/ whiteboards etc
