#### **Leodis Academies Trust Admissions Consultation**

We are consulting on the proposals and would like to hear your views and comments about these, so that we can decide whether to include these changes for the admissions policy for 2021/22.

The consultation is taking place from Tuesday 9 December 2019 to Friday 24 January 2020 via the online consultation survey

#### **Winter Weather Updates**

Every effort will be made for a message to be posted on the website before 7am should the school be forced to close. If parents do not receive a closure text or there is not a message on the website, the Academy is **open**.
