On-line Safety

It is still apparent some of our students are attached to unknown people via social networks, even when their account settings are private. For example, a number of students have accounts set to 'private' on Instagram but already have multiple 'followers' or are 'following' multiple people and they have no idea who they are. The problem is very similar with Snapchat and Facebook in particular.

Far too often, young people accept social media contact from strangers, which allows for contact via text chat and live streaming. In some instances, this leads to inappropriate images being requested or actually received and sent.

It is important to discuss the APPS your son/daughter use via phones or other devices. Please also discuss settings and people who they allow to have access to them via their accounts.
