Look Again Campaign



Child sexual exploitation affects thousands of children and young people across the UK every year. *Leeds Safeguarding Children Partnership* wants to remind people that males can be victims of CSE. Boys and young men are often overlooked as victims of child sexual exploitation (CSE). They are also less likely to report abuse or exploitation themselves, therefore practitioners need to be aware of the signs and indicators of abuse that boys may exhibit. Male victims of sexual exploitation are more likely to express trauma through anger, offending or aggression. As a consequence of this, many male victims are missed, because these types of behaviours may be seen as 'typical' in teenage boys. House System

As part of our commitment to all of our students working together and learning from each other, we are introducing a cross-age House System this year.

This system will mean that normal 'Form Tutor' time will be replaced with 'House Tutor' time during the registration period for six days over a two week period (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Tuesday, Wednesday), four times per year. In all cycles, Monday will remain a typical Form Tutor day to ensure that we maintain some of the key functions of our outstanding pastoral care.

The first cycle will take place on the following dates; 19 November, 20 November, 21 November, 22 November, 26 November and 27 November. The other three cycles start on 28 January, 17 March and 30 June 2020.

All students have been placed in one of the six Houses: Dentdale; Malhamdale; Ribblesdale; Ingleborough; Pen Y Ghent; or Whernside. All Houses will follow the same programme of activities, led by a House Tutor, designed to promote and develop a culture of community, family values and shared social responsibility. Students will have opportunities to engage with each other and flourish together in an environment that engenders fun and the formation of positive relationships, while learning and developing essential life-skills.
