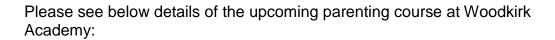
Children in Need Talent Show

Leeds Community Healthcare

ChatHealth

Over October half term Leeds Community Healthcare will be relaunching **ChatHealth**, which is a confidential texting service for 11-19 year olds to give young people direct access to expert healthcare advice and support via their mobile phone.

All young people in Leeds aged 11-19 can now receive confidential support from a 0-19 Specialist Public Health Nurse (previously known as a School Nurse), on a range of health related issues. These include: sexual health, emotional health and wellbeing, bullying, healthy eating and any other general health concerns.

ChatHealth is available Monday to Friday between 8.30am and 4.30pm, excluding bank holidays. Messages are responded to within one working day within these hours. Outside these hours, anyone sending a message to the service will receive an automated reply with advice on where to get help if their enquiry is urgent. Self-Harm App

Leeds City Council has been working alongside the NHS in Leeds to localise the national Calm Harm app. The app has been customised for young people in Leeds (aged 12 – 25 years old), using the MindMate imagery and directing them to the MindMate website for further information and support. The Calm Harm app helps you resist or manage the urge to self-harm; it has a number of activities including breathing techniques to help reduce symptoms of stress and anxiety. House System

As part of our commitment to all of our students working together and learning from each other, we are introducing a cross-age House System this year.

This system will mean that normal 'Form Tutor' time will be replaced with 'House Tutor' time during the registration period for six days over a two week period (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Tuesday, Wednesday), four times per year. In all cycles, Monday will remain a typical Form Tutor day to ensure that we maintain some of the key functions of our outstanding pastoral care.

The first cycle will take place on the following dates; 19 November, 20 November, 21 November, 22 November, 26 November and 27 November. The other three cycles start on 28 January, 17 March and 30 June 2020.

All students have been placed in one of the six Houses: Dentdale; Malhamdale; Ribblesdale; Ingleborough; Pen Y Ghent; or Whernside. All Houses will follow the same programme of activities, led by a House Tutor, designed to promote and develop a culture of community, family values and shared social responsibility. Students will have opportunities to engage with each other and flourish together in an environment that engenders fun and the formation of positive relationships, while learning and developing essential life-skills.
