A02 – Apply the A01 to a range of issues and items.

A03 – Analyse and evaluate. This involves making judgements, presenting arguments for and against.

PET – Practical, ethical theoretical. (Factors).

TRAMP – time, research opportunity, access, money and personality of researcher. (Practical factors).

DRIP – Deception, Right to Withdraw, Informed Consent, Protraction. (Ethics).

PERVERT – Practical, Ethical, Reliable, Valid, Evidence, Representative, Theory. (Use this to structure your longer answers).
