## **PARENTS CONTACTING SCHOOL**

#### **Progression of queries**

When contacting the school with a query, depending on its nature and seriousness, the query will progress along the following route:

- Year Tutor or Head of Department / Director of Faculty
- Vice Principal
- Associate Principal
- Principal

SCHOOL CONTACTING INDIVIDUAL PARENTS

- If your son/ daughter has been referred to the PSA
- If your son/ daughter has been given a fixed period in our Alternative Learning Centre {bungalow}
- If your son/ daughter has been given a Fixed Term Exclusion
