

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS COMMITTEE BYE LAW

1. STATUS

- 1.1 The International Students Committee exists to co-ordinate cross campus international campaigns and events as well as to raise awareness of issues faced by international students.

2. MEMBERSHIP

- 2.1 Ex Officio:
- 2.1.1 LUSU President;
 - 2.1.2 Vice President (Activities);
 - 2.1.3 Vice President (Education);
 - 2.1.4 Vice President (Campaign & Communications);
 - 2.1.5 Vice President (Union Development);
 - 2.1.6 Vice President (Welfare & Community);
 - 2.1.7 Cross Campus Officer International
 - 2.1.8 Cross Campus Officer Ethnic Minorities
- 2.2 Officers from Constituent Bodies
- 2.2.1 International Officers from all 8 undergraduate Colleges;
 - 2.2.2 One Representative from the PG Board;
 - 2.2.3 One JCR President, one Cross Campus Officer and one other officer (excluding FTOs) from the LUSU Council;
 - 2.2.4 One Representative from the LGBTQ+ committee;
 - 2.2.5 One Representative from the Women's forum.
 - 2.2.6 Cross Campus Officer Students with Disabilities

3. QUORUM

- 3.1 The meeting shall be chaired by the Cross Campus International Officer.
- 3.2 Quorum shall be one third of its current serving membership.

4. CHAIR

- 4.1 A Deputy Chair shall be elected termly by and from its members and shall not be a Full Time Executive Officer.
- 4.2 The Chair will conduct meetings as prescribed by Schedule C: Bye Law 5.

5. SPEAKING AND VOTING RIGHTS

- 5.1 All committee members have full speaking and voting rights for all items discussed by the International Students Association.

6. MEETINGS

- 6.1 The International Students Committee shall meet three times a term at the discretion of the Chair.
