Motion Name: Access to support and funding from SEH

Background:

- 1. The current process for the allocation of funding and support given to clubs via SEH is unclear and not transparent
- 2. As a result people in positions of leadership within these groups are left confused and disillusioned by the process which can hinder their club's development.
- 3. Furthermore those in leadership positions tend to only have one readily available point of contact within the department.
- 4. There is no clear information about how performance or kick start status influences support available to a club which can lead to confusion.
- 4. Support to be considered as recourses SEH provides or helps to provide clubs to include but not limited to: Coaching, Pitch time, transport to matches, access to additional recourses such as strength and conditioning, nutritional help, organisational assistance.

Purpose:

- 1. The creation of a clear transparent process for the allocation of support which recognises the value for student input
- 2. A detailed and readily available proves of support that accompanies funding
- 3. The creation of a level playing field for all clubs in terms of the access and influence they can exert over the funding and support they receive
- 4. The creation of multiple points of contact for leaders within the department to whom they may turn in order to resolve any issues regarding the above.
- 5. The creation of a clear list of support available to performance and kick start clubs.

Action:

- 1.Bristol Su through the sport and development officer and sports exec will work with SEH to critically assess the current process of allocation of support and funding to clubs
- 2. Student opinions to be actively sought by Bristol SU in a discrete and confidential manner empowering them to influence change.
- 3. A clear action plan will be developed by Bristol SU, the sports exec and students to address any issues raised by the assessment.
- 4. Bristol SU to work with SEH to create a clear list of support available to performance and kick start clubs.
