Motion Name: Remove Group Grants membership fee requirement

Background:

1. Student groups must have at least 30 members and charge a minimum membership fee of £2 to be eligible for Group Grants.
2. Many groups have other significant sources of income.
3. It is inappropriate for certain student groups to charge a membership fee.

Purpose:

1. Make Group Grants more accessible to all student groups.
2. Make student groups more accessible to all students by removing a reason for charging a membership fee where they would otherwise not do so.

Action:

1. Remove the membership fee eligibility requirement from Group Grants.
2. Modify the Group Grants application process to include a clear method to describe all the applicant group's income sources. This shall be used to demonstrate that applicant groups are financially sustainable and reasonable steps to self-fund have been taken.
