'Let's get Bristol's House in order'

In my current position as Club Captain of Volleyball and over my four years of University study, I've been heavily involved in Bristol Sport. During this time and in consultation with others I've identified a number of key areas within Sport and Student Development that I think need vast improvement, based around three core ideas of Participation, Community and Support.

PARTICIPATION

I WILL INCREASE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS PLAYING SPORT AT EVERY LEVEL BY:

- **Pay As You Go Sport:** Creating a 'Pay As You Go' scheme for all activities at Bristol – the ONLY reason someone shouldn't be active is because they don't want to, NOT because they can't afford it.
- **Student Engagement:** Seeking to remove barriers to participation, increasing and publicising an improved range of activities available to all students through Get Active and Fit & Fab.
- **Sports Pass System Review:** Improving the Sports pass system to get the best and most flexible deal for all students.
- **Models For Success:** Building participation models within clubs, ensuring everyone at University has the chance to play sport or get active.
- **Year Long Opportunities:** Ensuring there are regular taster sessions for sports and activities throughout the year.

COMMUNITY

I WILL ENHANCE THE BRISTOL SPORTING EXPERIENCE BY:

- **Pride:** Injecting pride and a sense of community into Bristol sport through the creation of a Bristol 'brand' and increased visibility of past achievements and ongoing success within facilities and grounds.
- **Intramural:** Creating a bigger intramural league system and expanding its benefits to the associated sports clubs.
- **BUCS Publicity:** Making Wednesday an important day for everyone at University through increased publicity of matches, reporting and live scores displayed on 'Game Day' screens around campus.
- **Varsity:** Making Varsity bigger and better, creating a structure that suits everyone's needs and includes all.
- **Facilities:** Improved access to facilities for all, through the Implementation of a transparent online booking system.

SUPPORT

I WILL BUILD A NETWORK OF SUPPORT AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR EVERYONE BY:

- **Opportunities Hub:** Creating a single space where all opportunities, ranging from societies to internships to volunteering, are listed and easily available.
- **Communication:** Drastically improving the way support and events are promoted to students.
- **Development:** Creating a program of leadership events that are relevant to student needs.
- **Drop-in Sessions:** Providing regular chances for students to express their views on all areas of Sport and Development.
- **Leader Recognition:** Ensuring that the incredible efforts put in by student leaders are recognised by more prominent award schemes.
- **Funding:** Improving funding allocation to clubs and societies to ensure they all have equal opportunities to go to competitions or hold events.
