

Introduction to the Schedules

These Schedules are an extension of the Constitution. They are designed to provide more detail guidance on how the Association operates. This includes matters that the Constitution requires to be laid out in the Schedules in further detail than they are in the Constitution.

These Schedules set out the working practices of the Association, which are made from time to time jointly by the Trustee Board and Student Representative Council.

If a dispute in interpretation arises, it is resolved by the Trustee Board.

These Schedules are a high level document. Where appropriate, further details are contained in supplementary documents. For example, the Chair of Student Representative Council is a post created and election process stated in the Student Representative Council Schedule, however the detail of the role is largely reserved for a supplementary document.

Supplementary documents are often named in the Schedules, and tied to a role and/or body who is responsible for their upkeep and approving for use.

By tying supplementary documents into the Schedules, supplementary documents become an extension of the relevant Schedule, and are binding on members and the Association as a whole.
