### International Students' Officer

The International Students' Officer represents international students (EU and non-EU) to the University and Bristol SU on all aspects of the international student experience. They champion the inclusion of international students and campaign against discrimination and barriers within both the University and the Union that impact international students. They also support and develop international student community through the International Students' Network.

Specifically, the International Students' Officer:

- Ensures that international students' interests are represented within University education and professional services, with a particular focus on liaising with the International Office.
- Supports and develops member-led groups championing international students or related issues
- Leads and empowers elected representatives with an international remit, for example those on JCR Committees
- Ensures that international students have access to good advice and information on matters relating to their University experience
- Supports and develops the International Students' Network and other Networks as appropriate.
- Works with the Sport and Student Development and Union Affairs Officers to ensure that Union and University activities, democracy and facilities are accessible and engaging to international Members.
- Works with the Postgraduate and Undergraduate Education Officer to ensure that the academic interests of international students are represented effectively
- Works with the Full-time Officers and the relevant Chairs of Networks to ensure that the interests of international Members are addressed in the development of Union and University policies.
- Works with the Equality, Liberation and Access Officer and the relevant Chairs of Networks to ensure that all international Members, with particular regard to underrepresented or minority groups of international Members, are represented on issues related to their experience at the University.
- Works with the Student Living Officer and relevant Chairs of Networks to ensure that international Members, are represented on issues related to their lifestyle, wellbeing, and accommodation.

As with all Full-time Officers, the Postgraduate Education Officer:

- Leads on a portfolio of policy passed by students.
- Leads on campaigning activity relevant to their role.
- Serves as a Trustee of the Students' Union.
- Works full-time and receives a salary c. £22,039.
