Postgraduate Education Officer

The Postgraduate Education Officer represents postgraduate students to the University and Bristol SU with respect to postgraduate taught and research academic and welfare matters (any concerns about assessments, supervision, tutoring, teaching, research environments and your wellbeing while studying). They also support and develop the postgraduate network.

Specifically, the Postgraduate Education Officer:

- Supports and develops a postgraduate community and liaises with the Bristol Doctoral College.
- Leads and empowers postgraduate academic elected representatives (Course and Faculty Reps).
- Ensures that postgrads have access to good advice and information on matters relating to their academic welfare and that their interests are represented within the University Student Services.
- Works with the Undergraduate Education Officer to represent, empower and champion academic societies and ensure that they are effectively representing and engaging with postgraduates.
- Supports and develops the Postgraduate Students' Network, Education Network and other Networks as appropriate.
- Works with other Elected Officers to ensure that all postgraduate students, with particular regard to under-represented or minority groups, are represented on issues related to their experience at the University and their interests are addressed in the development of postgraduate educational policies and strategy.
- Works with the Sport and Student Development Officer to represent the interests of postgraduates to the University on matters of personal development and promoting the importance of co-curricular activity and skills development within the wider student experience.

As with all Full-time Officers, the Postgraduate Education Officer:

- Leads on a portfolio of policy passed by students.
- Leads on campaigning activity relevant to their role.
- Serves as a Trustee of the Students' Union.
- Works full-time and receives a salary c. £22,039.
