Sport and Student Development Officer

The Sport and Student Development Officer represents students' interests in terms of sport, exercise and health and leads on ensuring that students have a variety of opportunities to engage in sport. They also lead on ensuring that students have opportunities for personal development.

Specifically, the Sport and Student Development Officer:

- Liaises with the University Centre for Sport, Exercise and Health and relevant external sporting organisations.
- Oversees the effective organisation and promotion of sports clubs, the varsity series and sports participation activities such as the intramural programme, Get Active and Fit and Fabulous
- Ensures that students have access to recreational sporting opportunities.
- Represents the interests of students on matters of personal development.
- Promotes the importance of co-curricular participation and skills development as part of the university experience.
- Ensures training and continuous development opportunities for students in leadership roles.
- Supports and develops the Sport and Wellbeing Networks and other Networks as appropriate.
- Works with the Union Affairs Officer to ensure that Bristol SU develops and maintains appropriate facilities for student activities and rewards and recognises those involved in Bristol SU activities.
- Works with the Equality, Liberation and Access Officer and relevant Chairs of Networks to ensure that the Union's Equality Policy is upheld in all Member-led sporting activities and to ensure any barriers to participation are alleviated.

As with all Full-time Officers, the Sport and Student Development Officer:

- Leads on a portfolio of policy passed by students.
- Leads on campaigning activity relevant to their role.
- Serves as a Trustee of the Students' Union.
- Works full-time and receives a salary c. £22,039.
