The NUS Conference election had 649 votes cast to fill four places so a quota of 129.8 needed at the first stage. Eddie Rees got 404 first preferences and as the only candidate to pass the quota his surplus of 274.2 votes was transferred with 180.2 votes being lost (having no second preference) whilst Neethu Edwin gained 21 votes and was elected with 145 votes, above the drooped quota. Stage 2 was the elimination of the candidate with least votes RON so the remaining two candidates Simon Peter Adabor and Hajra Anjum were elected to fill the remaining two places.

President Welfare's 607 valid votes (plus one spoilt ballot) gave an initial quota of 303.5, which no candidate passed at the first stage, although Elisha Lycett was in the lead with 256 first preferences (Esam Abdusamad was 2nd with 119). Therefore the two lowest candidates RON (6th with 14) and Sam Taylor (5th with 21) were both eliminated as neither could pass the 4th placed candidate. The quota drooped with the 80 lost votes to 263.5 which Elisha Gilbert passed with 273.0 after transfers so she was elected.
