



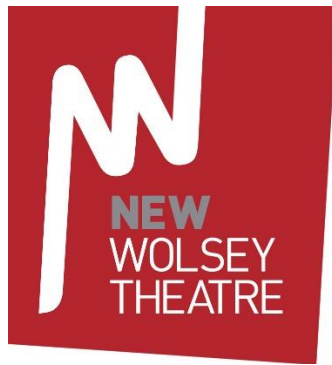
JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title:	Casual Technician
Responsible to:	Senior Technician, Stage / Senior Technician, Lighting and Sound
Job Purpose:	To work as part of the Technical Team giving full provision and facilitation of all technical requirements for all productions, projects and visiting programmes

Key Responsibilities:

- To assist within the team all aspects of get-ins, get-outs, rigging theatre equipment and staging where required
- To operate lighting, Sound and AV on in-house and visiting productions
- To be a pro-active member of the technical team
- To undertake general housekeeping of all technical and backstage areas
- To assist with the PAT programme of the New Wolsey Theatre
- To undertake Appointed Person responsibilities when required and trained to do so
- To undertake any other reasonable responsibilities as and when required
- To ensure all duties are performed working within current Health & Safety requirements and employing good, safe, working methods and practices
- It is expected that during your employment, you will continue to develop your technical skills and ability to work within a professional team
- To undertake any other reasonable responsibilities as and when required

JOB SPECIFICATION

Salary

Competitive rate of pay based on skillset and experience.
Time and a half on Sundays and Bank Holidays

Hours

All casual technicians are on a “zero hours” contract. Hours vary from shift to shift and week to week depending on the needs of the theatre

Shifts

Weekly departmental rotas are produced at least one week in advance. Shifts will vary dependant on activity for that week. Due to the nature of the role, you will frequently be required to work evenings and weekends

We always aim for staff to take two full days off a week however this may not always be possible due to the operational needs of the theatre

Annual Leave Entitlement

Weekly paid casual zero hours staff working at variable times will be paid for their holidays at set times throughout the year. Payments will be made quarterly in December, March, June and December based on hours worked during the previous three months. There will be certain times of the year when annual leave cannot be taken because of the work of the organisation

Uniform

Stage / lighting / production crew will be required to wear blacks when in rehearsal on stage or on show call

Personal Protective Equipment / Clothing will be supplied as required
