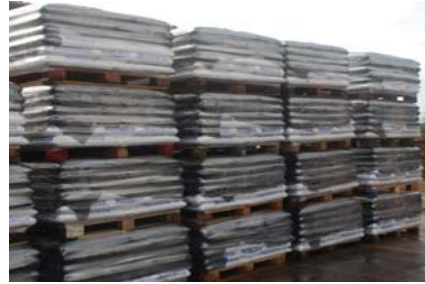




Using A Forklift To Stack Your Rock Salt

Storing rock salt is often a concern. Unfortunately, not every forklift driver knows the best ways to store rock salt, so we've produced a handy guide.

- Make sure that you have a fully qualified forklift driver and sufficient space to store the rock salt!
- You can safely stack bagged rock salt four pallets high enabling you store a lot of salt in quite a small area!



- Make sure the pallet is lifted completely clear before moving it to avoid catching and damaging salt bags.



- Only place the pallets on a level surface – the last thing you want is rock salt bags falling over on passers-by!
- Placing a black, waterproof cover entirely over your pallet and your rock salt bags will help to extend the life of the rock salt by helping lock out light and moisture.



- Finally, you'll need to make sure to stack pallets 'end ways' so if the forks on the lift are a little too large they won't puncture rows of rock salt behind.
