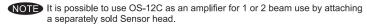

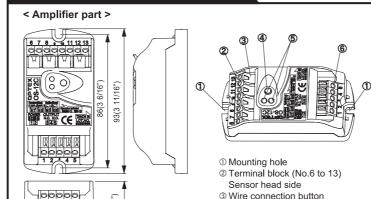
↑ WARNING Danger of electric shock.

Be sure to turn OFF the power supply when carrying out electrical works. Do not wash, disassemble, rebuild or repair the sensor by yourself.

Danger of getting caught between the door.

Even when someone stops on the threshold, the door closes unless the light beam is cut off (The beam switch outputs the signal only when the light beam is cut off). The beam switch is not designed as an apparatus to prevent accidents. It should be used strictly for the purpose of an auxiliary apparatus for safety.

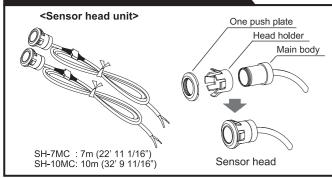

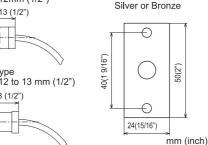

INSTALLATION

Mounting the sensor heads (Option)

1 One push installation type

Drill a mounting hole ø12mm (1/2") on the door jamb. Put the sensor heads into the mounting hole.



2 Plate installation type Drill a mounting hole ø12 to 13mm (1/2") and two screw hole ø3.5mm (1/2") on the door jamb.

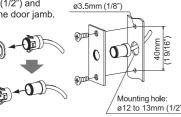

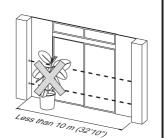

- ◆ On drilling the mounting holes ◆
- 1 Be sure to drill holes so that the sensor heads faces each other.
- 2. After drilling the holes, remove the flashes around the holes. Otherwise, the apparatus may not operate properly as the Sensor head rides on the flashes causing tilts.
- ◆ On setting of one push plate ◆

Be sure to push the sensor heads in securely. If the sensor heads are not secured, it may cause an unnecessary activation signal.

Do not place any swaving object

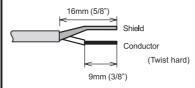

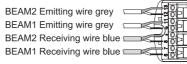

	Dirty lens.	Remove the dirt.
