

GB Number Dominoes

Contents:

28 dominoes, 1 reference board

Setting up

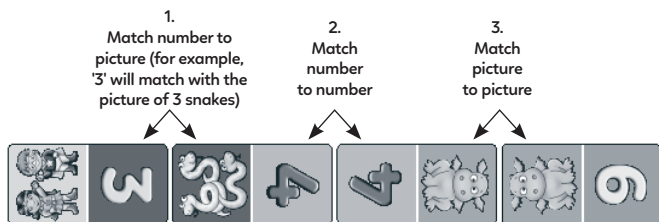
Shuffle the dominoes and deal seven to each player, placing the remaining dominoes in a facedown pile on the table.

Object

To be the first player to play all your dominoes.

To play

- The youngest player starts by placing one of their dominoes, face up, in the middle of the table.
- Play continues with the person on the player's left matching one of their dominoes to either end of the domino line. You can match in one of three ways:



- You must place your domino on the table with the matching ends touching. Play passes to the next player.
- If you are unable to play any of your dominoes, take a domino from the top of the main pile and add it to your own. Play passes to the next player.
- If you are unable to play any of your dominoes, and there are no more dominoes left in the pile, play passes to the next player.
- The game continues until nobody can match any of their dominoes, or someone uses up all their dominoes and wins the game.

The winner

The winner is the first person to play all of their dominoes or, if nobody can finish, the player with the fewest dominoes at the end of the game.
