




Easter Bunny Cup




Enjoy making your own bunny cup to play with this Easter! A simple craft activity that is perfect for keeping little ones busy and having fun over the Easter break.

You will need:

- 1 white cup • Pink paint • A paint brush • Pink shredded tissue paper • 1 white pipe cleaner
- A small white piece of paper • A small pink pom pom • A glue stick • Sticky tape • A pencil
- A pair of googly eyes (use black card if under 3 - choking hazard) • A grown up to help you




First draw your bunny's ears on the white card.



Then, with the help of a grown up, cut out your bunny's ears.



Next, paint the inside of your bunny's ears with pink paint.



Cut your white pipe cleaner in half and twist in the middle to make your bunny's whiskers.



Using the glue stick, stick on the googly eyes, whiskers and pom pom nose.



Your cup should now look like this.



Using glue or sticky tape stick your ears onto the back of your cup.



Finally, fill your cup with pink shredded tissue paper.



Hooray - your Easter bunny is now ready to play with!
