

Once Upon a Time Dominoes

Contents:

28 dominoes

Setting up

Shuffle the dominoes and deal 7 to each player, placing the remaining dominoes in a pile, face down on the table.

Object

To be the first player to play all their dominoes.

To play

- The youngest player starts by placing one of their dominoes, face up, in the middle of the table.
- Play continues with the person on the player's left matching a picture on one of their dominoes to one of the pictures on either end of the line of dominoes on the table. The player places their domino on the table with the matching ends touching.
- If a player is unable to play any of their dominoes, they take a domino from the main pile and add it to their own.
- If a player is unable to play any of their dominoes, and there are no more dominoes in the pile, play passes to the next player.
- The game continues until nobody can match any of their dominoes, or someone uses up all their dominoes and wins the game.

The winner

The winner is the first person to play all their dominoes or, if nobody can finish, the player with the fewest dominoes at the end of the game.
